- ROUND 2: it will be a rebuttal round in which students have to argue with each other and try to counter and prove that why their supporting point is more accurate.
- Prizes will be based on best speaker in favour of motion, best speaker against the motion, best team and rebuttal round winner
- The evaluation criteria will be announced at the commencement of competition liable to judges' decision
- Paper reading, copying and consultation of notes is not allowed and will lead to negative marking
- Speakers can only discuss the fact but cannot give any comment against any specific person/ government/ national institutes or any person
- Decisions of the judges will be final and un-challenged
