




Image-005: Students Practicing the BLS Skills



Report of the Workshop:



Digital Object Identifier (DOI) number should be checked for the authenticity of the journal Indexing He also discussed about the directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) as per NMC Guidelines and instructed all the faculty and students to first check the Meta Data before publishing in DOAJ Indexed Journals

- He also suggested the methods to retract/delete digital foot print of a paper if published in a fake or Cloned Journal. So that the same can be Published in an Indexed Journal.
- Faculty and student had active interaction and shared the names of Journals to check their authenticity.
- The session was started at 2:30 pm and was over by 4:30 pm by thanking Dr Sumit Narula, Resource Faculty and the participants. E-Certificates will be issued to all Participants.

<u>Awareness on Biotech Ignition Grant (BIG) and Startup Ecosystem & Quot –</u> 28.08.2020



Feedback form was also shared with the participants.





- 7. Publications in approved journal is a must. Those who are publishing in their research work in journals with high Impact Factor (genuine as per web of science database indexed journals) shall be given incentives/awards as per research promotion policy to encourage & keep them motivated.
- 8. There should be a dedicated page on research and facilities on college website.
- 9. A support (financial/&administrative) shall be followed for filing and processing of patent and should be clearly defined in HEI,s IPR policy.
- 10. Certificates were issued after successfully attending the webinar.
