

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

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC AND EDUCATIONAL COOPERATION

BETWEEN

CAUCASUS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (CIU) TBILISI, GEORGIA

AND

SANTOSH deemed to be UNIVERSITY GHAZIABAD, INDIA

Caucasus International University (CIU), located at 73 Chargali St. Tbilisi 0141, Georgia, represented by Rector- **Prof. Dr. Kakhaber Kordzaia** and **Santosh deemed to be University** (hereinafter referred to as **"Santosh"**), located at 1, Sector 12, **Santosh** Nagar, Pratap Vihar, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh 201009, represented by Dean (Academics) – **Dr Shalabh Gupta** seek to promote cooperation and advancement of international understanding. Considering their common interest in promoting mutual cooperation in the area of education and research, both institutions, therefore, wish to expand the basis for friendly and cooperative educational exchange and academic collaboration and have set forth the following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Nothing in this agreement shall be constructed as creating a legal relationship between institutions except as specifically provided in this MOU.

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

The purpose of the MOU is to develop academic and educational cooperation, especially in the fields and subfields, which are already delivered or might be taught at both institutions in the future and the fields in each university possesses a research interest and to promote relations and mutual understanding between the institutions.





ARTICLE II SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

Both institutions undertake to promote and develop academic cooperation in the following ways:

- 1. Encouraging academic exchange and cooperation between the institutions.
- 2. Organization of student's mobility in the scope of bachelor's, Master and Ph.D. Programs.
- 3. Inviting faculty members, research scholars, and/or students for academic visits and exchanges.
- 4. Co-sponsoring seminars, courses, workshops, and other academic meetings on matters of mutual benefit.
- 5. Publication of science works in periodicals of both Institutions.
- 6. Joint research activities in areas of mutual interest.
- 7. Assistance with developing relations and cooperation with industry and other institutes in each country.
- Developing joint dual degree programs at multiple levels. The details are to be considered by both institutions, with possible separate development and agreement, according to appropriate college and department requirements.
- 9. Recognition of the ECTS accumulated during the mobility period under the established internal recognition rule and procedures. (Caucasus International University: Mobility, Internal Mobility and Credit Recognition Procedure in Caucasus International University);

ARTICLE III ACTIVITIES AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 1. Both institutions agree that all specific arrangements and plans for activities are to be negotiated and are dependent on the availability of funds and resources for each such activity.
- 2. Both institutions agree to seek financial support from national and international organizations for the cooperative activities to be undertaken as stated under the terms of this MOU.

ARTICLE IV AGREEMENT OF IMPLEMENTATION

A detailed description of the scope of any activity described in this MOU and agreed to by the institutions shall be defined in a written and signed Agreement of Implementation, which shall supplement this MOU. An Agreement of Implementation will include such items as:

- 1. Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed-upon activity.
- 2. Schedule(s) for the specific activity.
- 3. Budgets and sources of financing for each activity.
- 4. Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity, for example, for procedures and ownership of intellectual property rights (see Article V below)





ARTICLE V INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND PUBLICATION

- 1. **CIU** and **Santosh** will share all data and research findings relating to this MOU and the relevant Agreement of Implementation; and ownership of any patent rights, copyrights, and other intellectual property rights to any discoveries, inventions, and products resulting from this MOU and an Agreement of Implementation that may be commercially useful will be determined based on the contribution of **CIU** and **Santosh**.
- 2. Both institutions must give written approval for the utilization and publication of any data and research findings resulting from a joint activity relating to this MOU and the relevant Agreement of Implementation.
- 3. Detailed management of Intellectual Property Rights and Publications shall be defined and provided in the agreement of Implementation of each activity.

ARTICLE VI SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

Any differing viewpoints or interpretations of this MOU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

ARTICLE VII MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. This MOU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of the two institutions.
- 2. This MOU shall be in effect from the date of its signing and be valid for the duration of 5 (five) years from that date, and will be automatically renewed on an annual basis thereafter unless terminated or replaced with a new MOU.
- 3. This MOU may be terminated by either party by written notice at least 6 (six) months in advance. In case the MOU ceases to be in effect on account of termination thereof, the provisions of the International Agreement for Academic Cooperation shall continue to apply to the extent necessary to secure the continued implementation of existing activities as agreed upon in the agreement.

WHEREAS:

- A. The parties hereto share a common interest in many academic and educational fields; and
- B. In order to facilitate future mutual institutional cooperation, the parties hereto wish to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding ("**MOU**").

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Objective.

The objective of this MOU is to outline the possible ways in which **KMU** and **Santosh**, could develop and carry out collaborative activities in academics and research.

2. Scope of Activities.

- 3. The point of contact for the duration of this MOU for Santosh will be the Dean for Academics <u>dean.academics@santosh.ac.in</u> or any other person appointed in his/her place by Santosh. The point of contact for the duration of this MOU for KMU will be the Acting Head of the International Cooperation Department Ghisa@qmu.kz or any other person appointed in his/her place by KMU.
- 4. Both Universities will respect the intellectual property rights of each other during the period of this MoU.
- 5. Each Party undertakes that it will not at any time use, divulge or communicate to any person, except to its professional representatives or advisers or as may be required by law or any legal or regulatory authority, any Confidential Information concerning the business or affairs of the other Party which may have come to its knowledge as a result of entering into this Memorandum and each of the Parties shall use its reasonable endeavours to prevent the publication or disclosure of any Confidential Information (of whatever nature and however recorded or preserved) disclosed by one Party to the other, which: (a) is marked as or has been otherwise indicated to be confidential, or (b) derives value to a Party from being confidential; except to the extent that such information is already in the public domain at the time of disclosure or enters the public domain otherwise than by a breach of any obligation of confidentiality.
- 6. Permission is given to **Santosh** to use the official marks of **KMU**, specifically the institutional name and/or institutional logo solely for the purposes of promoting and administering the collaborative activities between the institutions; provided, that **Santosh** shall take all such reasonable degree of care as an institution of good ethical and normal prudence would expect in its own case and notify **KMU** of the intent prior to usage.

Permission is given to **KMU** to use the official marks of **Santosh**, specifically the institutional name and/or institutional logo solely for the purposes of promoting and administering the collaborative activities between the institutions; provided, that **KMU** shall take all such reasonable degree of care as an institution of good ethical and normal prudence would expect in its own case and notify **Santosh** of the intent prior to usage

- 7. Not Legally Binding. This MOU is not intended to be and is not to be construed as a legally binding agreement. The signing of this MOU does not result in any material, financial or other obligation for either of the parties hereto. By signing this MOU, the parties are signifying their desire for future collaboration. Specific initiatives may be considered and agreed upon, on a case-to-case basis, including the contributions and obligations of each institution. Each such initiative shall be negotiated between the Parties and have a mutual agreement and shall be formalized by a signed appendix to this MOU.
- 8. **Term**. This MOU is effective for a period of 5 years from the date the MOU is signed by both parties. It may be extended or amended with the written agreement of both parties and may be terminated by either party with 6 (six) months' written notice to the other party. Any notice of termination should be addressed by sending an official email or written communication by post to the points of contact identified in Clause 3.





9. This MOU is completed in English and is signed in two (2) originals with one (1) original remaining in possession of each party.

Mari State University, a Government University established in 1972 at Yoshkar - Ola, Republic of Mari, Russia, hereinafter referred to as **Party B** for the purpose of this MoU). Mari State University deals with MD Physician (equivalent to MBBS course in India), various Post graduate courses in Medicine along with engineering, commerce, accounts and management programmes.

Both the parties initiate collaboration for mutual growth and expansion through this MoU.

This MoU also serves as a confidentiality agreement between the signing and executive authorities of both parties to safeguard confidential information shared during the course of administration of this MoU.

2. Scope

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The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- Academic and Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications.
- Exchange of students and faculty.
- Sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings.

2.1 Academic Research Collaboration in areas of mutual interest

Both institutions seek to facilitate research collaboration between their faculty through sharing of research ideas, data, and academic resources that could lead to joint publications. Such opportunities may include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's institution.

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Faculty from both Institutions will collaborate in the supervision of exchange students and in joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in **Annexure 1**.

2.2 Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications

Faculty from both institutions may exchange academic information (scholarly information, materials, publications, etc.) for academic enhancement in either institute's ecosystem.

2.3 Exchange of students and faculty

2.3.1 Student Exchange Programs

Both parties will seek to develop programs whereby their students have the opportunity to study at the other party's university/institute with mutual recognition of the credit hours arising therefrom. Pursuant to the agreement for academic exchange between **Party A and Party B** will exchange students according to the terms laid out in **Annexure 2**. It is desired by both parties that there will be a significant flow of students in both directions. Both Institutions may facilitate internship facilities for exchange students provided there are no legal and/or regulatory restrictions.

It is distinctively understood between the parties that this arrangement between the two parties is restricted to academic and cultural exchanges between students, faculty, and staff (offline and online) and is not to be construed or read to be intended for offering any academic awards including a Degree/Diploma.

Short Courses/ Summer School – These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer. The programs will facilitate visits by students and faculty to learn about the patient care ecosystem/ academic environment and pedagogy of education/Technological Development and research/ Cultural milieu and nursing care impacting patient care in the host country. In addition to various topics on hospital and healthcare services operations, the course would include meetings with medical directors, Superintendents, professors, research scholars, and visits to related hospitals and academic institutions to observe their working and practices.

The cost of such programs can be worked out separately each year, since they would be held in addition to the regular semester teaching.


2.3.3 Exchange of Faculty

Faculty Teaching

Both parties agree to develop opportunities for faculty to teach courses or conduct seminars at each other's location. Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe, develop, and share teaching methods and curricula.

Faculty members shall remain on the payroll of their home universities while teaching or researching at the host institutions. Both institutions shall assist each other in the necessary formalities for obtaining access to national or international scholarship funds.

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3. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representative of the partner institution and will remain in effect for five years. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner Institutions. However, each of the party of the Agreement will have the option to terminate this Agreement by giving Six Months prior notice without any Liabilities in any form to each other.

If either partner institution does not wish to continue the MOU at the end of the five years period it must notify the other institution not less than six months prior to the expiry of the MOU.

This agreement or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the agreement and exchange of letters between the two parties.

And the liaising for educational programs between the institutions will be managed under This MOU by SahaManthran Pvt Ltd, India and Party A. And therefore, will be shareholders of the program profits, which is to be defined at a later date on a caseto-gase basis after mutual discussions and acceptable forms.

2 Service Objectives

The objective of this Agreement is to secure alternative equipment for Blood Bank Santosh Medical and Dental College Hospitals and related services to a level that satisfies the requirements of the Blood Safety and Quality Regulations.

3 Services to be covered

The main elements of the services to be covered by this agreement are:

 Provision of Alternative blood bank services in case of any eventuality. In case of breakdown of any equipment and blood bank services, Blood Bank Santosh Medical and Dental College Hospital can utilize the services and equipment of Ghaziabad blood bank. Blood Bank can utilize facility for any testing purpose, component separation, storage and other services.

In case of breakdown of any equipment and other blood bank services, Life Line Blood Bank can utilize the services and equipment of Blood Bank, Santosh Medical and Dental College Hospitals. Blood Bank can utilize facility for any testing purpose, component separation, storage and other services.

- Provision of inter-blood bank staff staining Both the blood bank will coordinate and cooperate for training of blood bank staff and students respectively.
- Provision of blood components in case of emergency. In case of any emergency (non - availability of blood components), the blood banks will provide the back up to each other respectively.
- Provision of support staff and services for blood donation camps. Blood center Santosh Medical and Dental College Hospital and Ghaziabad blood bank will cooperate with each other and will provide the necessary staff and services for organizing indoor as well as outdoor blood donation camps respectively.

3 Location

Santosh Hospital Blood Banking services are provided from the Room no 222, second floor of Santosh Hospital, Ghaziabad. Ghaziabad Blood Bank is located 321/2 1" Flook Kalpana Building Kallupura , Ghaziabad. Both the blood bank operates in compliance with the Blood Safety and Quality Regulations.

4 Quality Management Specification

The originating Blood Bank undertakes to ensure that all blood and blood components will be accompanied by appropriate documentation and will be transported in a validated manner which ensures that the blood remain within specification throughout the transport period and until they are transferred to controlled temperature storage.

The supplying and receiving Blood Banks will adhere to the quality system for blood banks as required by the Drug and Cosmetic act. Where relevant, the following particulars will apply:

- There are standard operating procedures for the storage, and transport of blood and blood components within both the Blood Banks.
- Blood components will be transported in accordance with the Regional/National Transfer Policy
- "Cold chain" procedures, supported by documentary evidence, ensure specified temperatures and storage conditions are satisfactorily maintained at all times.
- Staff receive appropriate and regularly updated training in all of the above activities and appropriate records of this training are kept.

Traceability

It is essential that there is complete traceability for all units transferred.

Full records will be maintained of the transfer and return of all components and there will be a documented process in place to confirm the member of staff who transported and received the components.

The originating Blood bank will be responsible for full final traceability of units transferred to the other Blood Bank. At the time of transfer the originating Blood Bank will record that the units have been transferred. One trained technician will accompany. Technician accompanying the blood will be responsible for appropriate use of equipment and processing of components/testing, with permission and in presence of the staff of other Blood Bank where the facilities are being used.

6 Transport

Originating Blood Bank will be responsible for providing transport required for all products and will be responsible for all units in transit until their arrival at the receiving hospital has been documented.

7 Charging

THAT there shall be "No" financial commitments / obligations by both the parties for extending their mutual support and consent

9 Compliance

The originatingblood bank will wish to assure themselves that the procedures and practices within the receiving blood bank satisfy the requirements of this Agreement.

10 Remedies for Non-Performance

In the event of either party not performing according to the agreed terms of this Technical Agreement, the following procedures will apply: -

- Where one party considers that the other party has failed to meet its obligations, that party will
 initiate a meeting with the other within four weeks.
- Following the meeting, the party which has not performed adequately will be given four weeks to
