- THEME: AWARENESS OF ANY MEDICAL ISSUE**
- Street plays can be in Hindi or English or Bilingual
- Time limit: 10 minutes. Warning bell will be rung after 8 minutes. Marks will be deducted for every minute taken after the time limit
- Usage of abusive language is strictly prohibited and may lead to disqualification
- Judges' collective decision will be final and binding
- Use of any sort of hazardous element/prop is strictly prohibited
- Performance should be confined within the allotted area, as defined by the organizers
- No technical support will be provided
- No props are allowed. Teams can use banners and posters. Teams are allowed to use musical props as Dholak, Flute or any other music instrument of their choice, but usage of mikes, lights, or any electrical instruments is not allowed
- Team size: Maximum of 15 members and minimum 10 members
- No professional assistance is permitted, all team members should be certified students of the institute. Please bring along your identity cards

- Team size: 4 members MAXIMUM (Including for instruments)
- Time limit: 10 minutes. Warning bell will be rung after 8 minutes
- Marks will be deducted for every minute taken after the time limit
- Usage of abusive language is strictly prohibited and may lead to disqualification.
- Judges' collective decision will be final and binding
- Participants have to bring their own instruments. Only 2 instruments are allowed either electrical or non-electrical. Drums are NOT ALLOWED Only 4 mics will be provided
- All the requirements should be told by the team leader to the events coordinator on prior basis
- No professional assistance is permitted, all team members should be certified students of the institute. Please bring along your identity cards

- ROUND 2: it will be a rebuttal round in which students have to argue with each other and try to counter and prove that why their supporting point is more accurate
- Prizes will be based on best speaker in favour of motion, best speaker against the motion, best team and rebuttal round winner
- The evaluation criteria will be announced at the commencement of competition liable to judges' decision
- Paper reading, copying and consultation of notes is not allowed and will lead to negative marking
- Speakers can only discuss the fact but cannot give any comment against any specific person/ government/ national institutes or any person
- Decisions of the judges will be final and un-challenged
