#### Report on Faculty Development Program on Self Directed Learning and Early Clinical Exposure

A faculty development workshop was conducted by the Medical Education Unit on 31st August 2022 from 2.00 PM- 5.00 PM. The workshop was conducted on Self Directed Learning by Dr. Alka Agrawal and Early Clinical Exposure by Dr. Shalabh Gupta.

45 Faculty from different streams registered and attended the workshop.

The two student centric methods of teaching were discussed in detail. The workshop on Self Directed Learning encompassed both the two stages of SDL where in Dr Alka Agrawal gave a live demonstration on how the SDL works and how it is differentiated from other methods like tutorials, case discussions etc. A case scenario was shared and a role play conducted through flip chart to go through the various steps of SDL.

The topic of Early clinical Exposure, covered by Dr. Shalabh Gupta, included three activities. The first and second activities focused on what different students would decipher from the same theoretical curricula. The third activity trained the faculty in developing a module on providing early clinical exposure to first professional students to relevant clinical conditions and scales for patient assessment.

The workshop was well appreciated including the clarity of the concept for efficient teaching by the faculty and feedback was also taken after the workshop.






#### Report on Awareness on Human Rights



Thirty students came forward and met with the members of the Student Research Cell and showed interest.



Feedback form was also shared with the participants.




