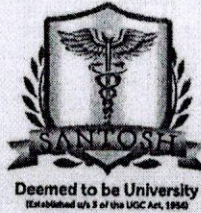

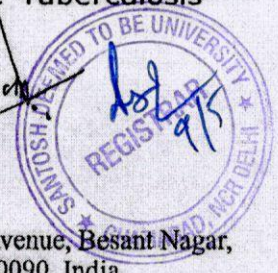
Purpose & Scope

Venue: Board Room 4th floor

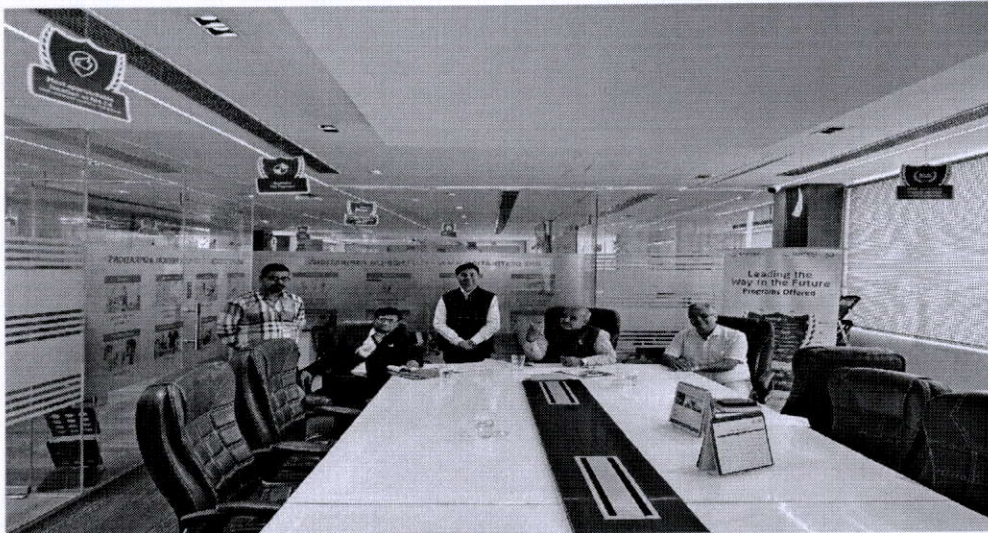
