Objective of the awareness session was to impart knowledge and create awareness about the importance of deworming, mainly for children from 1 to 19 years of age.

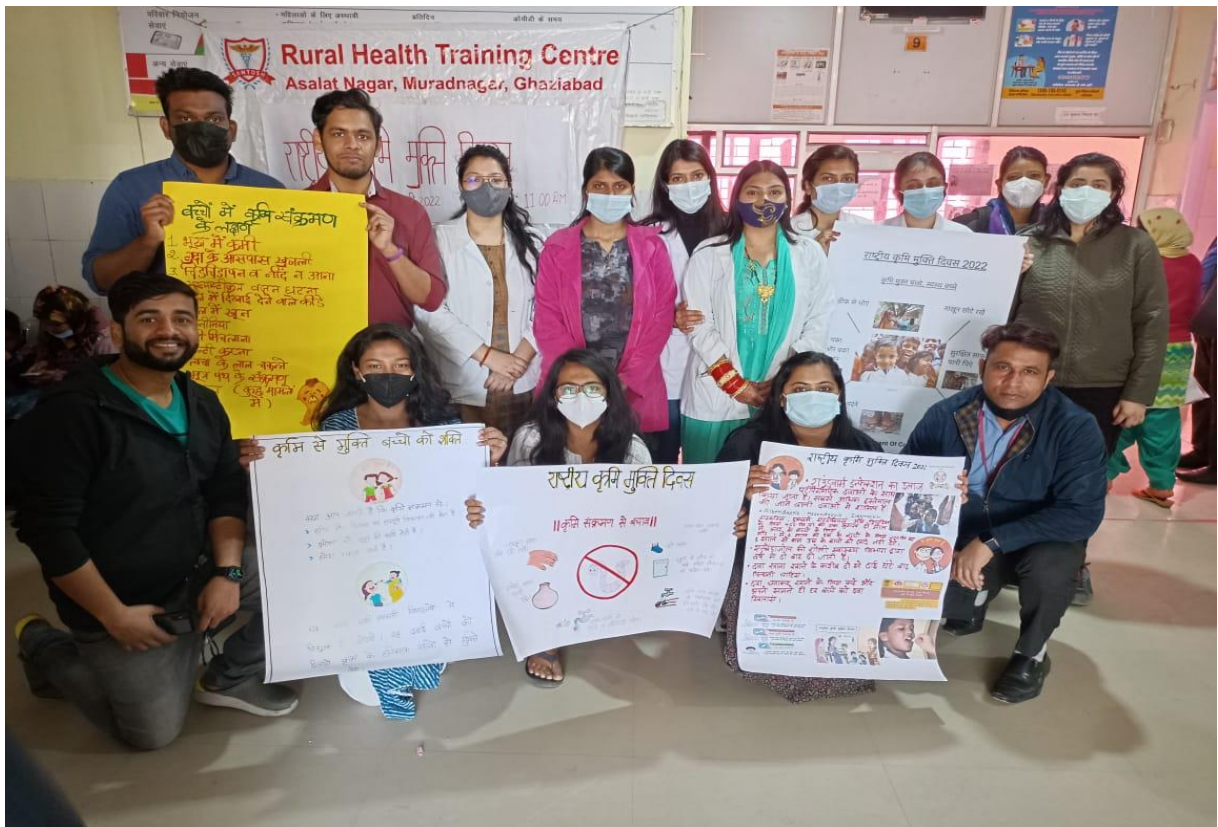

Field visit to Sewage Treatment Plant, Indirapuram

Field visit to Sewage Treatment Plant, Indirapuram Ghaziabad by Post graduate students and interns of Community Medicine Department on 20.10.20

The Department of Community Medicine, Santosh Medical College, organised a field visit to Sewage treatment plant Indirapuram Ghaziabad, for postgraduate trainee's & interns on 20/10/2020 to gain knowledge about the various processes, components and procedures involved in treating the sewage.

Total Participants= Six

The students arrived at the facility around 10:30 am and were received by Mr. Anuj Verma, who was assigned to them by the authorities for demonstration purpose. After taking the mandatory precautions like head gear (helmet's) and observing the general COVID19 social advisory, our tour of the sewage plant was started.

Mr Anuj first showed the students the diagrammatic representation of the entire plant with all its components and explained to them, the procedures involved at every level as the sewage moved into different compartments, before actually taking them to the individual compartments.

The Sewage plant begins with the main sewage inlet which is received into a compartment containing the "Coarse Screen" with a 40 mm size screen or filter, allowing only particles smaller than 40 mm to pass through .The next compartment is the main pumping station which harbours motors which pump the contents up the higher compartments at fixed flow rate ,there is an electronic meter which shows the rate of flow continuously. Sewage is now received in a stilling chamber which has a "Fine Screen" of 6 mm size which further reduces the particle size which is carried across the membrane. From here the sewage moves into the so called "GRIT chambers" which further sediments the sewage components. Sewage from the grit chambers passes to the distribution chamber via the PARSHALL FLUME. Distribution chambers feed the SBR tanks where the sewage is treated with oxygen as per the COD & BOD (chemical and biological oxygen demand). The outlet of the SBR Tanks is treated with chlorine in the post SBR compartment as needed and the outlet water is now treated and ready for disposal in the Hindon river and can be used for agricultural purpose.

Prior to being fed in the SBR tanks, at three different levels 1) coarse screen 2) fine screen and 3) after the grid chambers sludge is collected. Sludge collected from the SBR tanks is then thickened in another chamber before being centrifugated and finally collected for dumping.

Outlet water was tested daily for the following parameters

- 1) Ph
- 2) D.O mg/l
- 3) TEMPERATURE Degree C

- 4) C.O.D mg/l less than or equal to 100
- 5) B.O.D mg/l less than or equal to 10
- 6) TSS mg/l less than or equal to 10

The students were shown the contents of the inlet and outlet in a chemical beaker to visually appreciate the contrast. the chemical laboratory daily conducts the testing of both the raw sewage as well as the treated sewage for various parameters as per government regulations.

The tour concluded with a visit to the laboratory.

VISIT TO THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT ON 5TH OF DECEMBER 2020

The Department of Community Medicine, Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad, organised a field visit to the Water Treatment Plant located in Siddharth Vihar area of Ghaziabad, for enhancing the training of interns and post graduate students in the field of community medicine. These field visits orient them towards the public health aspects of drinking water. Here is a short report of the same:

The team reached the plant at the prior fixed time. After visiting the different chambers, we finally arrived at the laboratory section of the plant where we were informed about the different tests which are performed to ensure the safety and quality of the water as per the standards set by the local & international agencies (W.H.O).

Apart from the physical processes involved, water is mainly treated with chlorine, to kill the microbes in the water. Chlorination is used to prevent the spread of waterborne diseases.

The second main goal is to treat the water for turbidity (haziness) by adding chemicals like Poly ammonium chloride. WHO recommends a less than five NTU (nephelometric turbidity units) value of drinking water, and we were informed that the water at the facility had an NTU value of approximately <1. Water is also tested for pH, TDS, Etc. With this our visit concluded.

Total gathering was more than 40 in number.

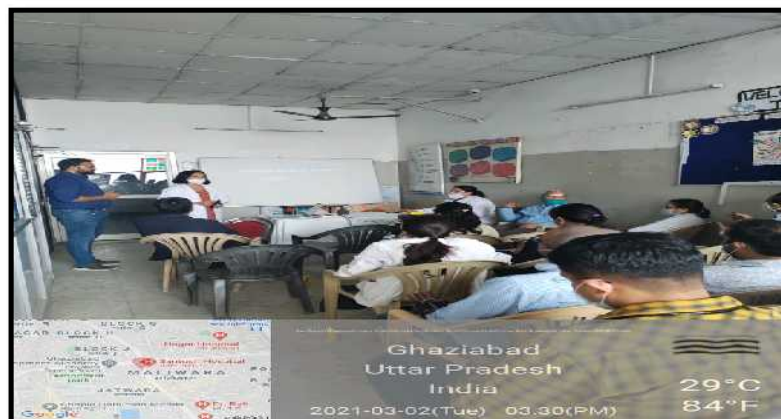
