9. Thus the whole activity was a great success.



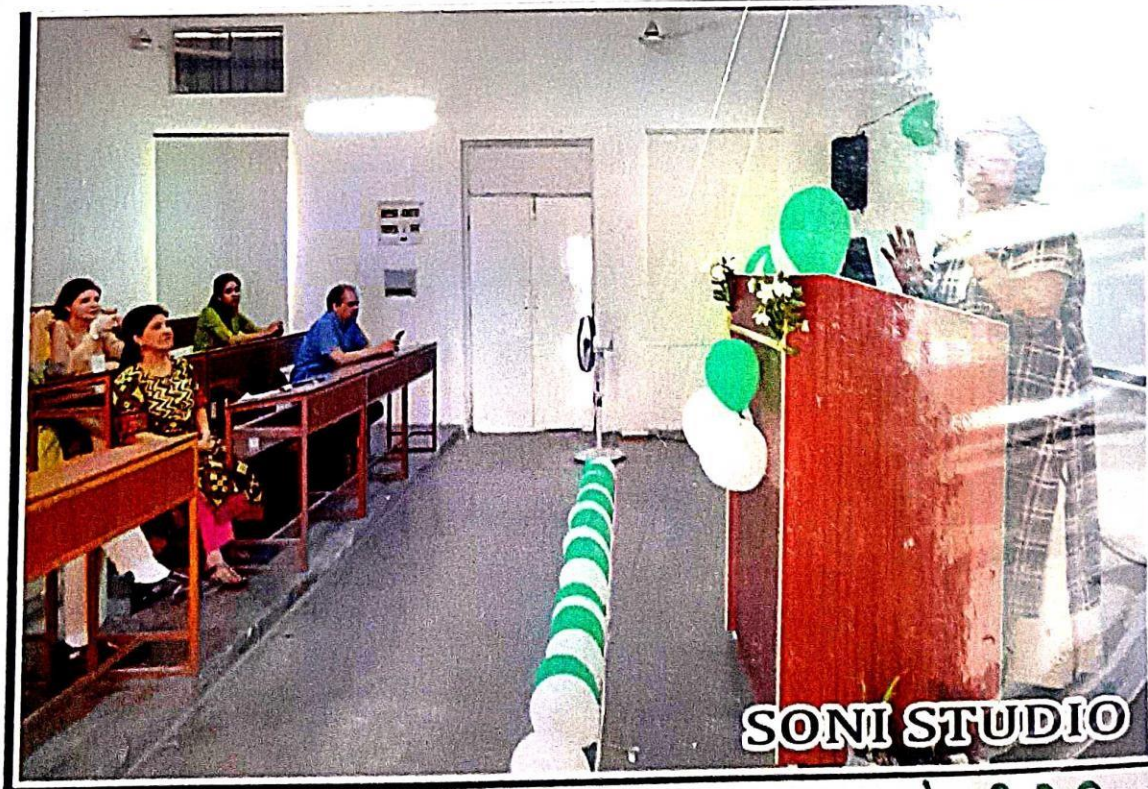
