DATE: 1st July 2022

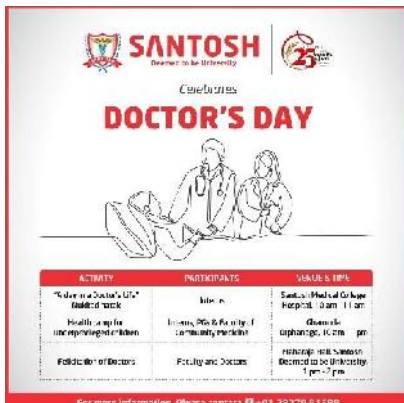
#### **REPORT**

- Doctor's Day was celebrated in Santosh Medical College with a lot of enthusiasm and fervour. On this day, various activities were planned in the medical college and hospital as well as the field practice areas of the Dept of Community Medicine. The event was circulated on the different social networks.
- The health camp was organised in collaboration with Gharonda, a home for underprivileged children.
- The day started with a Nukkad Natak presented by interns and undergraduate medical students in the Santosh Hospital, depicting 'A day in the life of a Doctor'. It dealt with the everyday challenges faced by the doctors including aggression by relatives of patients and how the doctors provide services against all odds. Faculty and other staff members of the hospital applauded the nukkad natak.
- A free health camp was organised on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022, in Gharonda which is an orphanage in district Ghaziabad, by Department of Community Medicine, Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad. A total of 30 children who were between the ages of 3 months to 10 years were examined. Patients requiring advanced treatment were advised to visit higher centre (Santosh Hospital) for

respective speciality. Dental examination of the children was also done by dental post graduate students. All children were given Albendazole tablets and syrup for deworming. The camp culminated with juices and snacks distribution to the underprivileged children of Gharonda.

- The day ended with felicitation of the doctors for their valuable contribution during the COVID 19 pandemic.

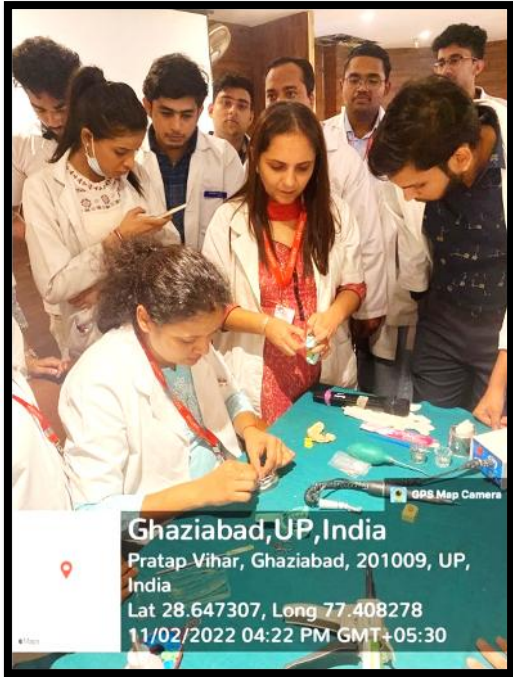
## REPORT

**Name of the skill:** Mantoux test

**Department:** Microbiology

### **Details of skill:**

Mantoux test, also known as Tuberculin skin test is a tool for screening tuberculosis and for tuberculosis diagnosis. The skill programme was attended by undergraduate students of medical college, paramedical and postgraduate dental college students. Under this activity the skill was demonstrated under three sections:

a) Administration of Mantoux test

b) Reading of results

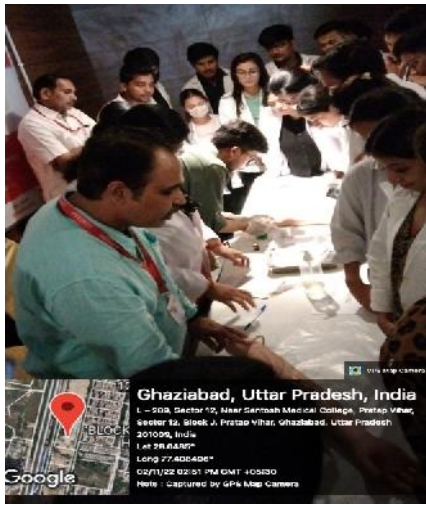
c) Interpretation of Mantoux test

The preparation steps included collecting of supplies, providing patient education, washing hands, locating and cleaning the injection site, and preparing the syringe. When preparing to administer the Mantoux tuberculin skin test, the area for administering the test should have a firm, well-lit surface, and that equipment and supplies should be ready. Supplies should include a vial of tuberculin, a single-dose disposable tuberculin syringe, a ruler with millimeter (mm) measurements, 2x2 gauze pads or cottonballs, alcohol swabs, a puncture resistant sharps disposal container, record-keeping forms for the patient and provider, and a pen. The tuberculin is administered using a single-dose disposable tuberculin syringe that has a one quarter to one-half inch, 27-gauge needle with a short bevel.

Participants were explained about the principle and method of Mantoux administration on suitable mannequins. Students were explained about the process of reading of the test. They were shown the results through charts and diagrams and also explained about the interpretation of results. The participants were given role play to demonstrate Mantoux test on each other. In addition to Mantoux test students were also emphasized on hand hygiene and biomedical waste management. The skill workshop was a great success and each participant enjoyed it a lot.

**Objective:** To impart cognitive as well as psychomotor skills of oro-tracheal Intubation which in turn helps provide emergency care. This skills training pledge to bestow information and hands-on practice in Orotracheal intubation

**Activities:** Dr Debapriya Sarkar gave the students a brief introduction about definition, indication, equipment, and manoeuvres related to oro-tracheal intubation. Then the students were divided in two groups and with the help of two high fidelity intubation mannequin, they were given hands on training on oro-tracheal intubation.

**OUTCOMES:** Students obtained necessary knowledge and skills to perform oro-tracheal intubation in elective and emergency scenarios.

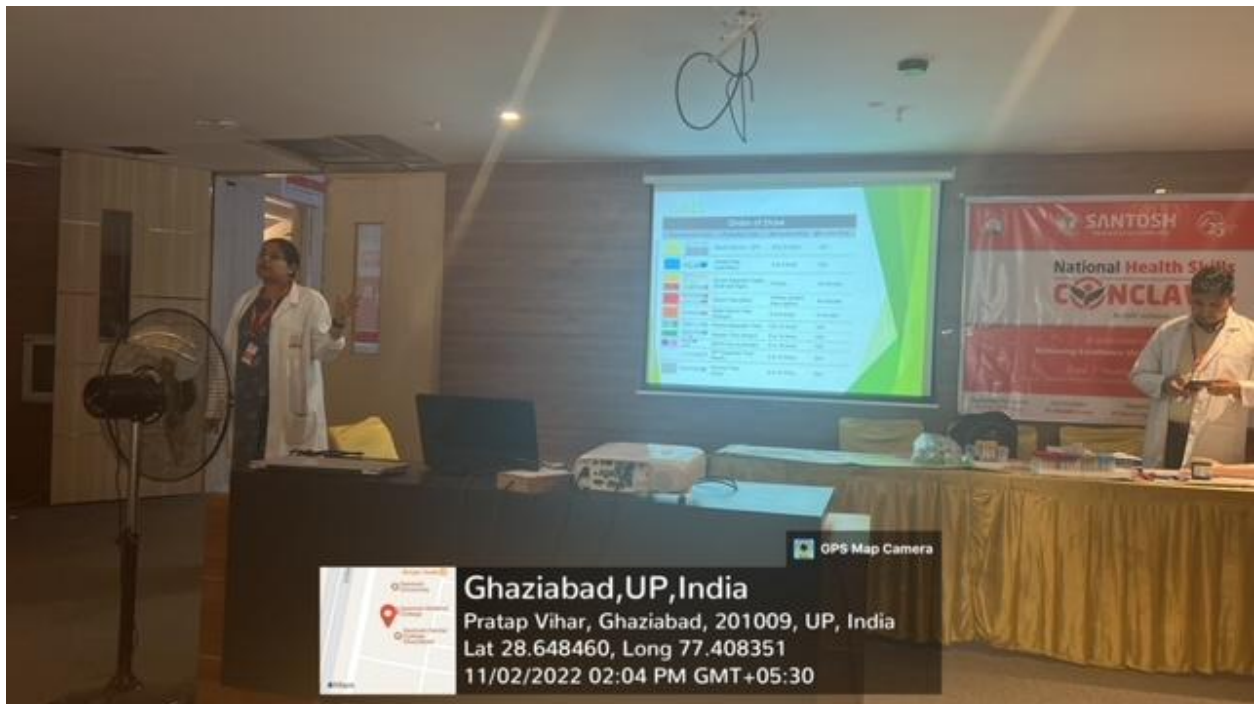
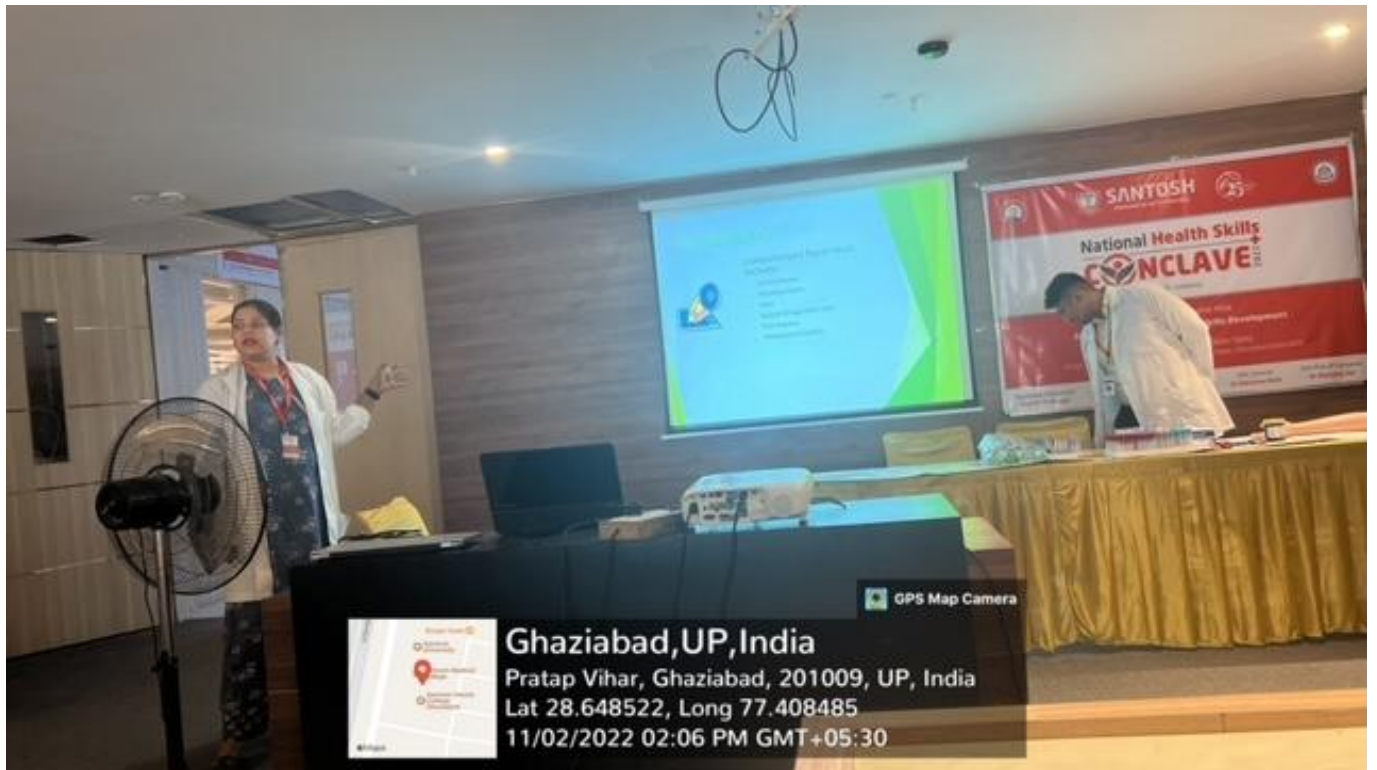
Details of Skill:

The Phlebotomy session at the Skill Conclave was conducted from 2-3 PM at Hall B on 2.11.2022. The students were divided into two batches with Microbiology and Biochemistry conducting the sessions simultaneously. After half hour each the batches were swapped between the departments. Each session started with the presentation on Phlebotomy given by Dr. Juhi Aggarwal, Head of Department, Biochemistry. The principles of phlebotomy were discussed by Dr. Eram.

The presentation introduced to the students the topic of Phlebotomy, its history and the duties of a phlebotomist. The presentation also illustrated the different types of tubes used in Phlebotomy and impressed upon the participants the importance and rationale of the order of draw to be followed while collecting a sample. The presentation illustrated the various sites for drawing blood and concluded with the common problems that may be encountered while drawing blood.

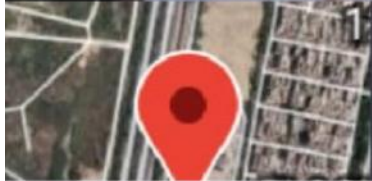
Following the presentation, the students were demonstrated the technique of phlebotomy on Mannequins by Mr. Bhisim Chaudhary, Senior Technician, Central Lab, Santosh Hospital. The different colour coded tubes were displayed and the analyte's estimated in each tube was discussed. In addition, needles of different gauges were also shown to the participants. The students were given the hands-on opportunity to identify and palpate the vein, draw the blood from the mannequin and transferring the blood to different tubes. The ideal methods of phlebotomy was discussed during the demonstration and the questions raised by the participants were addressed after the demonstration. The session concluded with a group photo of the instructors and participants. The enthusiastic participation of the students encouraged the faculty to bring about various other biochemical techniques for hands on training.

## Event report

### Immunisation workshop- 02.11.22

Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad organised National Health Skills Conclave workshop on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2022. Department of Community Medicine held session on 'Basics of immunization and immunisation techniques'. Dr. Anupama Singh (Assistant Professor) coordinated and facilitated the session. Discussions were held on national immunisation schedule, types of vaccines, cold chain, open vial policy, heat and freeze sensitive vaccines and demonstration of the different techniques of giving intradermal, subcutaneous, intramuscular and oral vaccination was done. - This proved an exciting and practical way for students to improve their theoretical knowledge in the understanding of human anatomy.





The program was coordinated with the Student Core Committee members and all the efforts were appreciated in the end with vote of thanks by Dean Student Welfare.

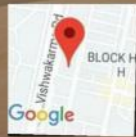




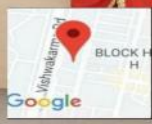

Targeted audience was rural area people mainly women and children because majorly these people are not aware about the services provided and when and where they have to go.

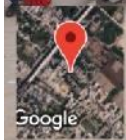

team A (Dr. Naman Sahni, Dr. Akshay kumar, Dr. Shivang Patel and Dr. Aarav Jawa) won the first prize.

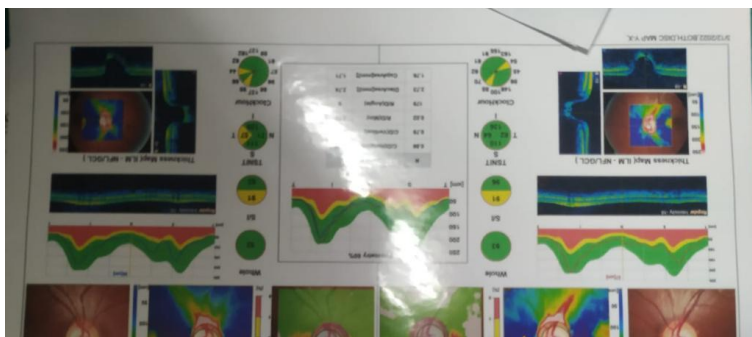

9. Table Tennis : Held on 12 December, 2021 in the collage premises. Several girls competed to be the table tennis conqueror.



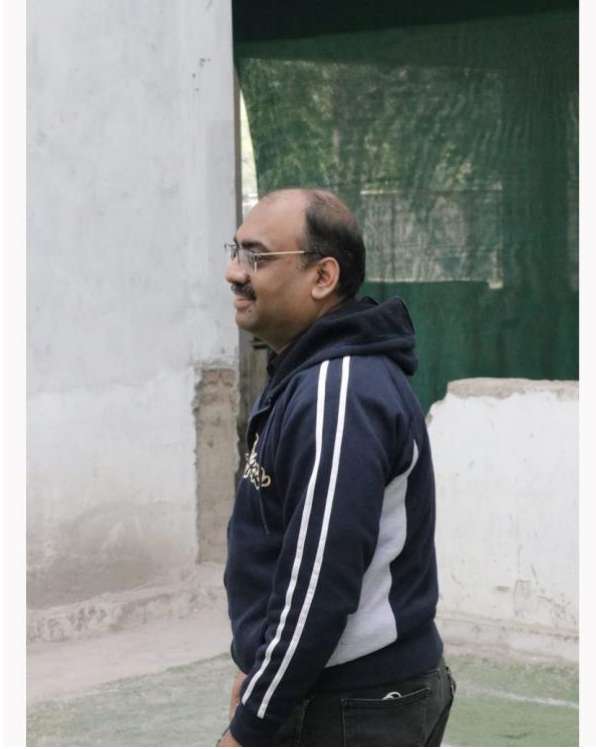


## **Recreation of Faculty:**

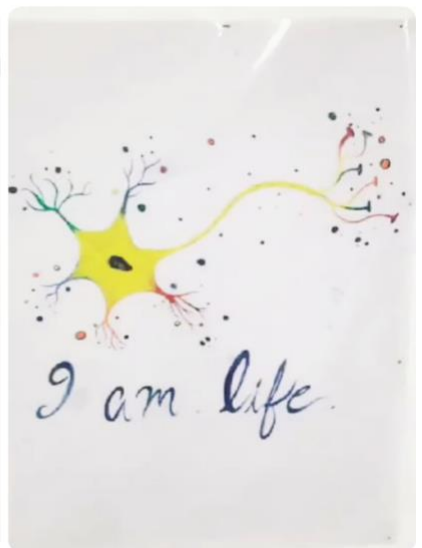
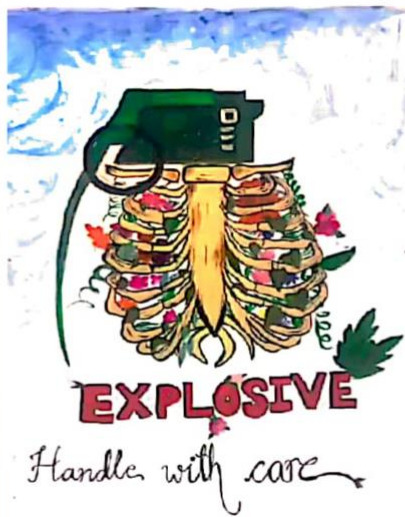
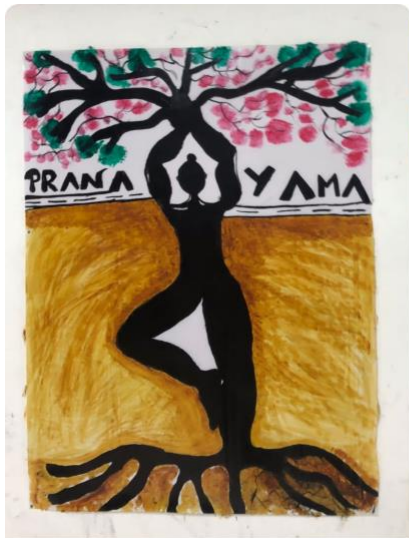


#### 4. Wall Painting / Decoration:

This is especially critical in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic that has put End TB progress at risk, and to ensure equitable access to prevention and care in line with WHO's drive towards achieving Universal Health Coverage.

World TB Day is observed on March 24 each year to raise public awareness and understanding about one of the world's deadliest infectious killers - TB and its devastating health, social and economic impact on people around the world. March 24 marks the day in 1882 when Dr Robert Koch announced that he had discovered the bacterium that causes TB, which opened the way towards diagnosing and curing this disease.

Every day, over 4100 people die from TB and nearly 30 000 people fall ill with TB disease – despite it being preventable and treatable. TB is the leading cause of death of people with HIV and a major contributor to antimicrobial resistance. World TB Day is an opportunity to focus on the people affected by this disease and to call for accelerated action to end TB suffering and deaths, especially in the midst of the ongoing COVID-19 crisis.

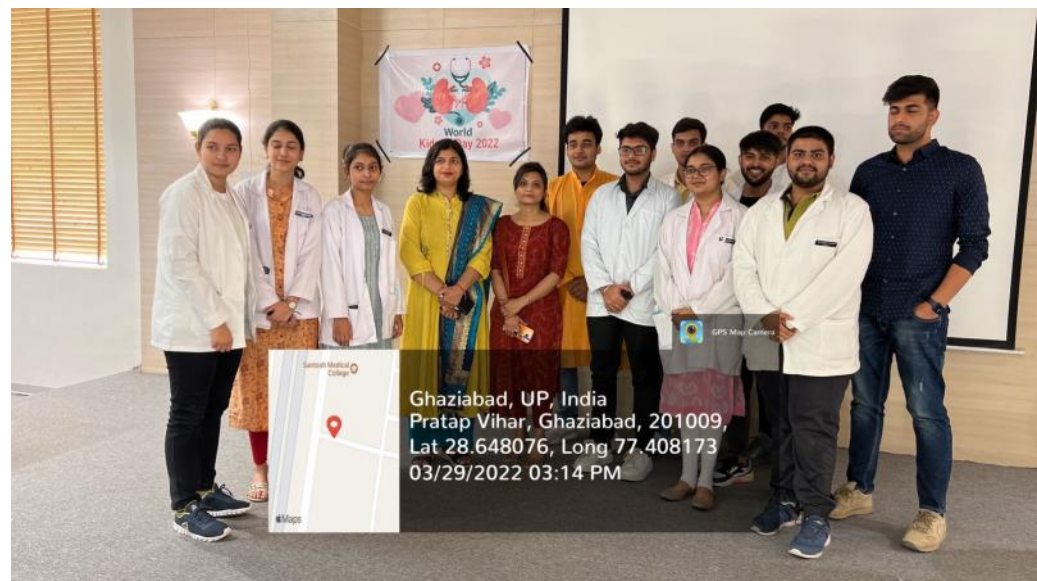
## National Kidney Month
