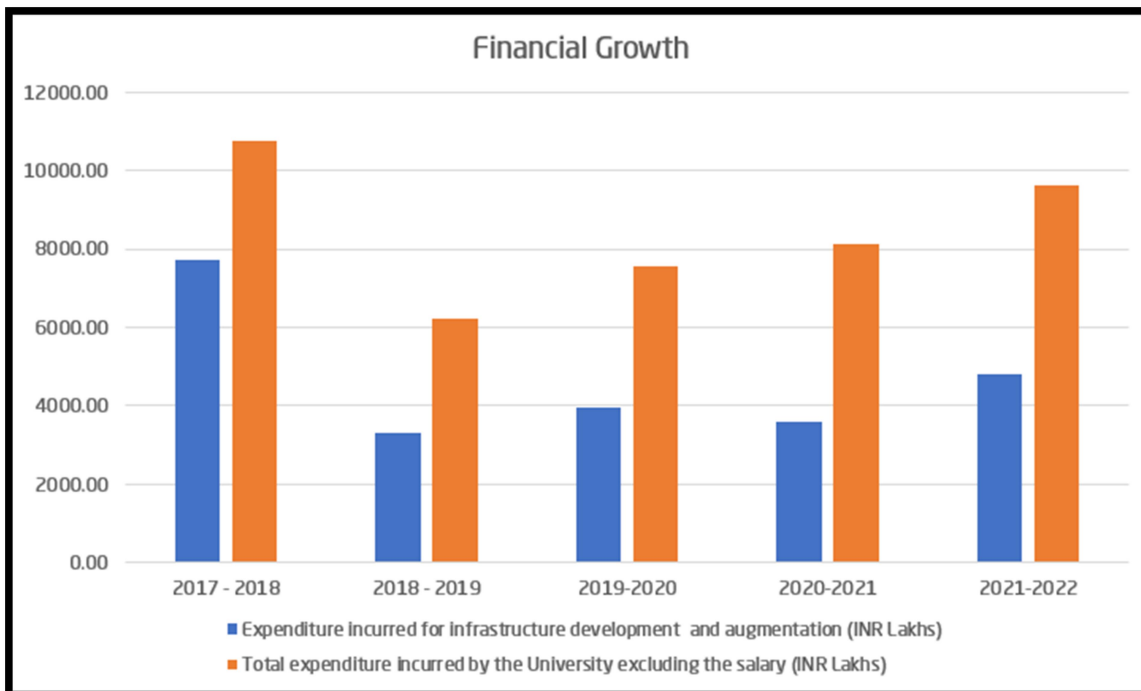
Research Innovation & Extension

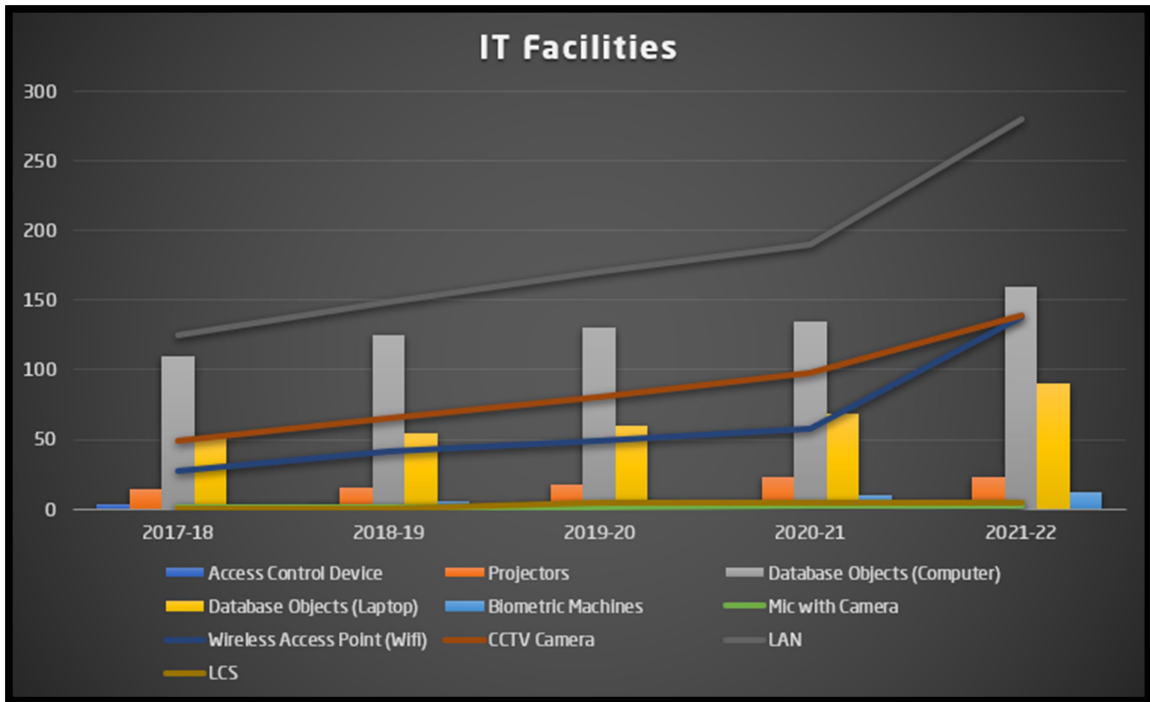
