Introduction

A unique model Institution, Santosh Deemed to be University serves as a distinct institution delivering quality medical/dental education & healthcare services. In addition to offering degrees in Medicine & Dentistry, the University provides an environment for translational research and innovations in health sciences and comprehensive healthcare.

SANTOSH (Deemed-to-be University) has its roots in a group of Institutions established by the Santosh Trust. The Trust was established in 1995 by one of India's DYNAMIC CARDIOLOGIST, with the mission of empowering youth through quality, affordable health education and health services. The Trust has established 2 institutions spread in two campuses at Ghaziabad UP.

Santosh Medical College and Hospital and Santosh Dental College are the two colleges of the Trust, then affiliated to Ch, Charan Singh University and later was declared the two constituent Units of Santosh "Deemed to be University" by Ministry of Human Resource Development on 6th June 2007. Attaining the University status Ghaziabad based standalone Santosh Deemed to be University a health University is one of the perfect templates to define quality induced education. For any institution to rise above all and flourish, the quint essential pre-requisite needed is a body of dedicated faculty, sincere administration, and diligent students. When all these three meets and amalgamate, then we get a perfect blend of learning. Santosh University provides today's health sciences students with distinguished and committed faculty, who provide thoughtful and humanistic mentoring. State of the art learning facilities and clinical Labs.in teaching Hospitals. All the colleges are supported by on campus super-specialty teaching and network group of Hospitals. All the courses are recognized by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of the Government of India.

The university has been offering an MBBS course since 1995 with a total intake of around 50 students per year. 2005 onwards, the course was recognized by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of the Government of India and the capacity capacity of accepting a particular number of admissions was increased to 100. 25years after its inception, the institute is considered as the best medical university of India.

In the same manner, Santosh Dental College started in 1995 with an aim of imparting a higher level education in dentistry. The institution offers a foundation course in BDS since 1996 by accepting about 40 students annually. But the number of admissions went up higher to 100 per year after 2005.

In 2022 the MBBS seats were increased from 100 to 150 and Postgraduate seats were also increased. Two more streams of Post graduation was also added to the Medical College, in Radiology 6 MD seats and 3 Emergency Medicine Seats were added.

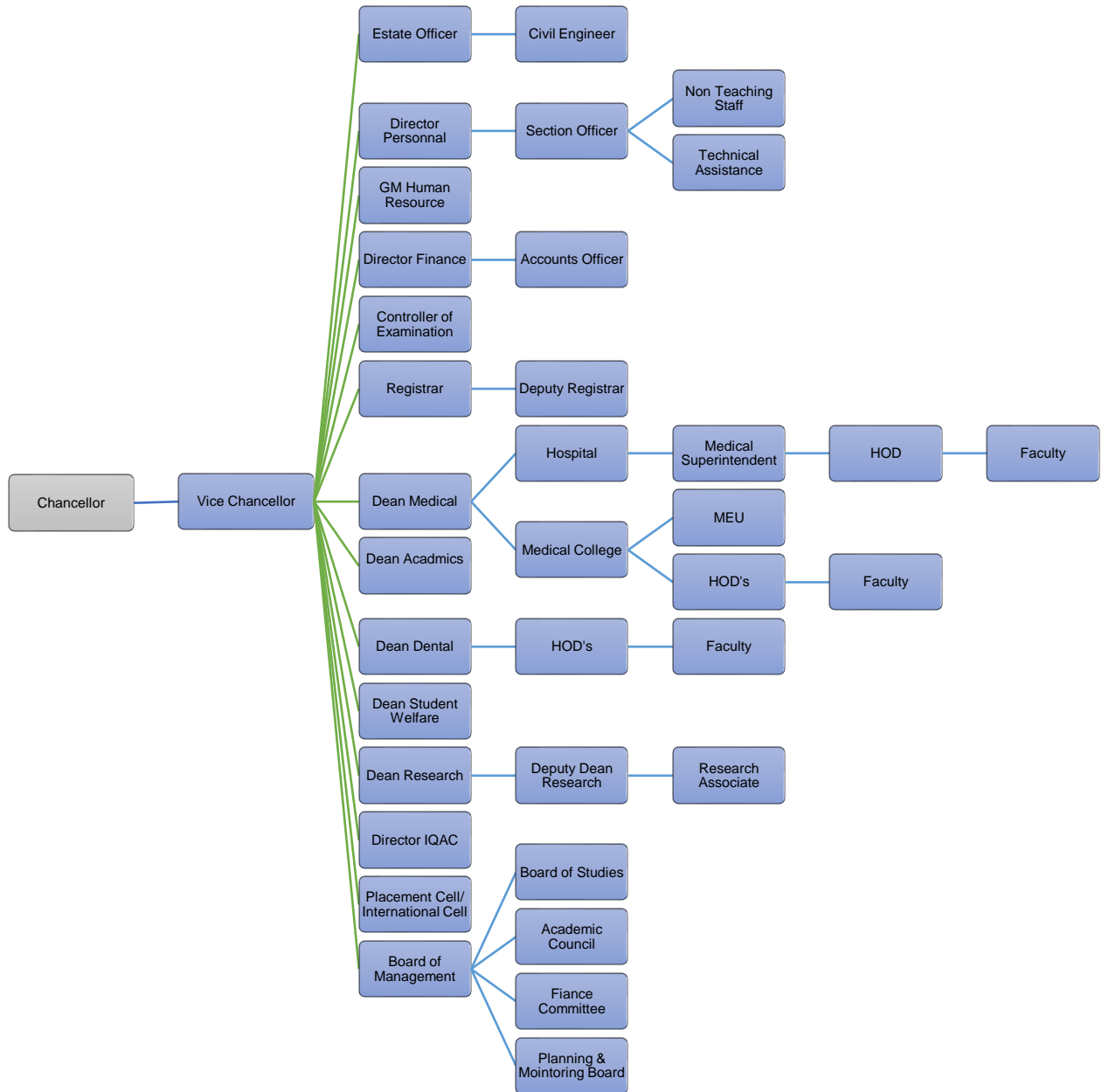
The offices of Santosh Deemed to be University are housed on the 4th floor of the Medical College. The University currently offers 44 programs in disciplines related to health sciences and dental Sciences.

These include undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral and diploma programs. The University has attracted students from almost all the states of India as well as from international destinations. The professional programs have received uninterrupted recognition from the respective statutory Regulatory authorities.

M.Sc and Ph.D Courses were introduced in 2012 which were under the Ambit of Santosh Deemed to be University. . The students are provided with a plethora of 27 value added courses. In addition to their curriculum, 6 teaching programs are offered at the UG, PG and Ph.D. levels through 29 departments. The students are facilitated to participate in community-connect programs of village adoption, implementation of all national programs which enable them to evolve as holistic citizens of the country.

We have a standardized 'Mentor-Mentee system' which helps to assess the slow-learners and advanced learners on entry and implement special programs for both the groups without any stigmatization. Each mentor would have 10 students under their teacher-parent care system, which will take care of both academic and personal issues. These approaches include bridge and remedial courses, communication skill courses, and psychological counselling services for slow learners. The advanced learners are provided opportunities to take additional courses with extra credits, research projects, conference participation, etc., it is seen that this system has made normalization of all students and everyone becomes equally competent.

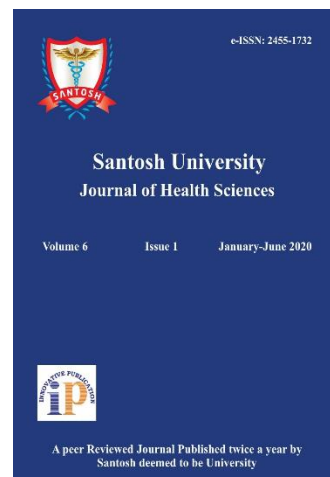

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS

(Academic Year: 2019-20)

As the University is a Deemed to be University declared under section 3 of the UGC act 1956, the Controller of Examinations takes the sole responsibility of the evaluation protocols and procedures for the conduct of all the University Examinations for its Constituent Units, viz.: Santosh Medical College & Hospital and Santosh Dental College & Hospital.

Examination Procedures followed:

1. Panel of 5 External Examiners are obtained from the respective Heads of the Departments.
 2. Vice-Chancellor selects any two external examiners from the panel and 2 sets of question papers for each course are obtained from each external examiners.
 3. Altogether around 345 sets of question papers have been received from the external examiners for various subjects / papers for this year for the conduct of all Regular and Supplementary Examinations at all levels.
 4. Moderation committee members were constituted by the Vice-Chancellor and accordingly question papers are evaluated for validity and difficulty level of the question paper are also assessed simultaneously.
 5. The date sheet / schedule of examinations are communicated to the students through mail and through physical copies in the Notice Board of the Institutions.
 6. Three sets of question papers are prepared, printed and sealed for each of the courses for University Examinations and on the day of examinations, 10 mins. prior to the start of the examinations, a person nominated by the Vice-Chancellor chooses one set of sealed covers among the three sets in front of all the students in the examination hall every day.
 7. All Examinations are conducted with Integrity and with high discipline.

9. After the examinations, the answer scripts were collected and bundled in the respective covers and properly sealed.
10. The Answer scripts were evaluated by both Internal and External Examiners as per the regulations and the results are sent to the Academic Section in sealed covers.
11. For this Academic Year a total of 136 Internal Examiners were appointed from the Institution and 138 External Examiners were invited for the conduct of Practical Examinations and Valuation of Theory Papers.
12. After the results are tabulated and checked, the Vice-Chancellor constitutes a Result Declaration Board and passes the result to be published and accordingly the results are published in the Notice Board and in the University Website.

Declaration of Results:

- The Examinations for I MBBS, I M.Sc., III M.Sc., III BDS were conducted from 19th July 2019 to 19th August 2019 and the results have been published on 30th August 2019.
 - The Examinations for IV BDS was conducted from 18th July 2019 to 28th August 2019 and the results have been published on 30th August 2019.
 - The Examinations for II MBBS, III MBBS Part-I & III MBBS Part-II, were conducted from 20th February 2020 to 14th March 2020 and the results have been published on 25th March 2020.
 - The Examinations for MD/MS/PG Diploma courses, MDS First Year & MDS Final Year were conducted from 15th June 2020 to 28nd June 2020 and the results have been published on 30th July 2020. The duration for declaration of results was extended as per the guidelines of Govt. of India in the midst of COVID pandemic times.

- **CALL TO ACTION -**
- The world cannot afford another generation deceived by the lies of the tobacco industry, which pretends to promote freedom of personal choice while really ensuring eternal profits – regardless of the millions of people that pay with their life each year.
- WHO urges influencers – in pop culture, on social media, in the home, or in the classroom – who reach and connect with youth to expose the industries' manipulative tactics to create a new generation of tobacco users.

Tobacco use and COVID-19 –

- Tobacco smoking is a known risk factor for many respiratory infections and increases the severity of respiratory diseases. A review of studies by public health experts convened by WHO on 29 April 2020 found that smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers.
- COVID-19 is an infectious disease that primarily attacks the lungs. Smoking impairs lung function making it harder for the body to fight off coronaviruses and other diseases. Tobacco is also a major risk factor for non-communicable diseases like cardiovascular disease, cancer, respiratory disease and diabetes which put people with these conditions at higher risk for developing severe illness when affected by COVID-19. Available research suggests that smokers are at higher risk of developing severe disease and death.

- The topic was tobacco addiction and how to tackle it. Dr Vijaya discussed in depth the various contributing factors that make people addicted to tobacco

consumption. She also discussed the impact nicotine has on the human body and mind so as to impart knowledge about the withdrawal symptoms the addicts show.

- The talk also focused on how smokeless tobacco consumption is more detrimental to the health of people and how sometimes it is ignored during the no tobacco talks. Moreover she also talked about the necessary support system that people need so that they can effectively quit this habit.
- However she also stressed on the permanent nature of damage that tobacco consumption has on the lungs, mouth and other parts of the human body.
