The Santosh Medical/ Dental Colleges & Hospitals, Ghaziabad, were established by the "Maharaji Educational Trust", Registered under the Indian Trust Act, in the Year 1995. The Govt. of India vide their letter no. U.12012/25/95-ME (P), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. New Delhi, dated 15th January 1996 was granted permissions for conducting MBBS course with 50 Admissions annually and later on the same was increased from 50 to 100 admissions annually from the academic year 2005-2006 vide the Government of India, Ministry of Health Family Welfare's Letter No.U.12012/79/2001-ME(P-II) dated the 15 July 2005


Similarly, the Santosh Dental Collage was also granted permission for conducting BDS course with 40 admissions annually from the year 1995 vide the Government of India, Ministry of Health Family Welfare's Letter No. V.12017/12/95-PMS dated 11-01-1996 and later on the same was increased from 40 to 100 admissions annually from the academic year 2005—2006 vide the Government of India, Ministry of Health Family Welfare's letter No.12317/46/2002 PMS dated 07-07-2004. The Santosh Medical & Dental Colleges Were affiliated with the Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut vide their Letter No. Affiliation/ Self Finance/2025 Dated the 15 June 2005.

The Central Government of India vide their No.F.9-2/2003-U.3, Ministry of Human Recourse Development (Department of Higher Education) New Delhi, dated June 13 2007. Declared the Santosh Medical & Dental College, Ghaziabad as one of the institutions, deemed to be University in the name and style at Santosh University Ghaziabad on the recommendations of the University Grants Commission vide their Letter: No. F6- 77/2004/ CCP-I dated 18-05-2007. Presently various Post Graduate Medical Degree and Post Graduate Dental Degree Courses are successfully running under the ambit of the Samoan Deemed to be University with the prior of approval of the Medical Council of India and Dental Council of India. Besides the PG Degree, courses in Medical & Dental, various Medical Diplomas, and M.Sc. in the Medical disciplines and Ph.D. Medical and Dental disciplines are also running successfully under the ambit of Santosh Deemed to be University.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS

(Academic Year: 2017-18)

As the University is a Deemed to be University declared under section 3 of the UGC act 1956, the Controller of Examinations takes the sole responsibility of the evaluation protocols and procedures for the conduct of all the University Examinations for its Constituent Units, viz.: Santosh Medical College & Hospital and Santosh Dental College & Hospital.

Examination Procedures followed:

- Panel of 5 External Examiners are obtained from the respective Heads of the Departments.
- 2. Vice-Chancellor selects any two external examiners from the panel and 2 sets of question papers for each course are obtained from each external examiners.
- Altogether 210 sets of question papers have been received from the external examiners for various subjects / papers for this year for the conduct of all Regular and Supplementary Examinations at all levels.
- Moderation committee members were constituted by the Vice-Chancellor and accordingly question papers are evaluated for validity and difficulty level of the question paper are also assessed simultaneously.
- The date sheet / schedule of examinations are communicated to the students through mail and through physical copies in the Notice Board of the Institutions.
- 6. Three sets of question papers are prepared, printed and sealed for each of the courses for University Examinations and on the day of examinations, 10 mins. prior to the start of the examinations, a person nominated by the Vice-Chancellor chooses one set of sealed covers among the three sets in front of all the students in the examination hall every day.
- All regular theory examination for MBBS 1st Prof was conducted during Aug.2017 and MBBS 2nd. 3rd & Final Prof Eaxamionationswere conducted during Feb.2018. The Supplementary Examinations for MBBS

- 8. All Examinations are conducted with Integrity and with high discipline.
- After the examinations, the answer scripts were collected and bundled in the respective covers and properly sealed.
- 10.The Answer scripts were evaluated by both Internal and External Examiners as per the regulations and the results are sent to the Academic Section in sealed covers.
- 11.After the results are tabulated and checked, the Vice-Chancellor constitutes a Result Declaration Board and passes the result to be published and accordingly the results are published in the Notice Board and in the University Website.
- 12.After the result are tabulated and checked, the Vice-Chancellor constitutes a Result Declaration Board and passes the result to be published and accordingly the results are published in the Notice Board and in the University Website.

Declaration of Results:

- The Examinations for I MBBS, I MSc., III MSc., I BDS, II BDS & IV BDS were conducted from 24TH July 2017 to 25th August 2017 and the results have been published on 30th August 2017.
- The Examinations for II MBBS, III MBBS Part-I & III MBBS Part-II, were conducted from 21st February 2018 to 15th March 2018 and the results have been published on 26th March 2018.
- The Examinations for MD/MS/PG Diploma courses, MDS First Year and MDS Final Year were conducted from 2nd May 2018 to 12th May 2018 and the results have been published on 30th May 2018.




