TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR RECOGNITION OF SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATIONS (SIROs)


1. The organizations should acknowledge receipt of the recognition letter by stating that they will abide by the terms and conditions of recognition.
2. The recognition will entitle the SIRO to receive such administrative support from the DSIR, Ministry of Science & Technology as may be required on issue to promote or encourage scientific research activities.
3. SIROs recognized by DSIR are also deemed to be registered. A separate certificate of registration** is issued along with the recognition letter. The recognition would be valid for the period specified in the recognition letter and application for renewal of recognition shall be submitted in the prescribed proforma at least 3 months before the expiry of the valid recognition. Failure to submit application in time may lead to automatic lapsing of the recognition & registration.
***However, the certificate of registration is not issued to SIROs engaged in activities falling within the definition of 'hospital' as per notification No. 51/96-Cus. Dt. 23.07.1996 issued by the Department of Revenue.*
4. The recognition of DSIR does not amount to approval u/s 35(1)(ii)/(iii) of Income Tax Act, 1961.
5. The registration will entitle the SIROs to avail of custom duty exemption on purchase of equipment, instruments, spares thereof, consumables, etc. used for research and development subject to relevant Government policies in force from time to time. The realization, if any, from above or any services rendered etc. shall be shown in the R&D accounts of the organization as income of the SIRO in the audited accounts as well as annual report and should be used or reinvested for research activities only. 9. Brief summary of the achievements of the organization shall be submitted to the DSIR every year. This should include details related to papers published, patents obtained and process developed, new products introduced, awards & prizes received, copy of Annual Report and Statement of Accounts of the organization etc. List of equipment, instruments, parts and consumables imported/purchased using the duty exemption should also be submitted to DSIR along with the Annual Report.
10. Any violation of the terms & conditions mentioned-above and / or provisions of taxation in force will make the organization liable to de-recognition.
11. The organization will also conform to such other conditions for recognition stipulated in the Guidelines or as may be specifically provided in the recognition letter.

In spite of these changes, ethics education has not received adequate attention in medical schools throughout the world. There is an emerging need for introduction of teaching medical ethics as a consequence of several social and scientific processes.

There is good evidence to prove that many medical schools will sincerely welcome guidance in the teaching of ethics. They will send physicians to courses; they will welcome novel methods of teaching the subject, they will adopt a new syllabus either in its entirety or insofar as it suits their environment. 

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Introduction

In recent decades' medical education curricula have undergone many modifications for a variety of reasons. In spite of these changes, ethics education has not received adequate attention in medical schools throughout the world. There is an emerging need for introduction of teaching medical ethics as a consequence of several social and scientific processes.

There is good evidence to prove that many medical schools will sincerely welcome guidance in the teaching of ethics. They will send physicians to courses; they will welcome novel methods of teaching the subject, they will adopt a new syllabus either in its entirety or insofar as it suits their environment. Universities and institutions realize that a 21st century ethical approach by physicians to their colleagues as well as to their patients will strengthen the efficiency of the medical profession. The need for a modernized curriculum derives not only from the fact that many of the existent curricula are antiquated and completely out of tune with the intricacies of recent scientific advances, but also from the safeguards which we require in the form of educational innovations which will insemminate ethical values into our students, in spite of this materialistic age in which we live in. The UNESCO Chair adopted the idea and undertook the mission.

The Asia Pacific Bioethics Division of the UNESCO Chair Haifa acknowledges this region is host to over 60% of the global population. With the advent of Globalisation, this has impacted on many regions and societies in the Asia Pacific are rapidly facing transformation and transition both happening simultaneously. This has brought about significant changes. Consequently, leading to change in Social scenarios. These can impact on Cultural identities and expressions affecting not only

arts, language but also Values traditions, norms. This has brought new ethical challenges in many areas and importantly Bioethics that doctors and health care profession have now to confront.

The Aims of The Asia Pacific Bioethics Division of the UNESCO Chair Haifa

The Network will aim to be the leader in the region mandated to study and develop curriculum teaching, training and research in the changing bioethics needs of the populations of the region, using the network's national units of the UNESCO chair in Bioethics.

- The network will aim to ameliorate the current teaching of ethics in medical schools in the regions by dialogue and deliberations among the national units of the network and explore pilot initiatives in teaching and training methods with evaluations of the new and current initiatives in order that evidence based methods and content might be developed to bridge the gap in the identified post-modern ethics education and practice needs of this era.

- The network will offer opportunities to train and research the area of bioethics. Bioethics is based on the premise of complexity and approaches problems inherent to humanity and its environment in a Trans disciplinary manner. Its object of study and of intervention is the perpetual and specific interplay of the interrelationships between humans, humans and their environment and humans moved by ethical principals in accordance with their respective nationalities and cultures.
