1. Name of the Course

"Fine Needle Aspiration and Exfoliative Cytology"

2. Duration of the Course

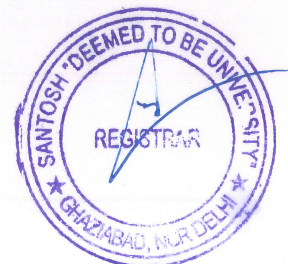
The course will be conducted with 4 hours Session for 4 weeks and there shall be 2 batches per year containing 20 candidates per batch. [After the scheduled curriculum]

3. Eligibility Criteria

- MBBS students who have passed Phase – II are eligible to apply for the programme.

4. Course Fee: Rs. 10,000/- per student

5. Course Director: Dr. Malay Bajpai, Professor



6. Objectives & Scope of the program:

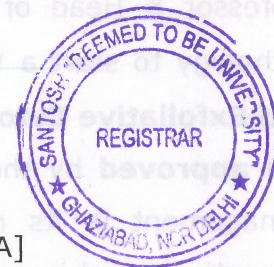
The main objective of this course is to provide training in the Methods and Techniques of FNAC and exfoliative cytology and also exposure to screening of PAP smears. The scientific program includes lectures by eminent faculty covering various topics on FNAC and exfoliative cytology along with interactive slide microscopy, case discussions, demonstration of FNAC procedure and lab techniques.

7. Methodology & Syllabus

Includes Introduction and Basics of cytology, Procedure of FNAC, Stains used in cytology, Hands-on staining techniques, Exfoliative cytology basics, PAP smear procedure, Introduction to Bethesda system, Interesting slides discussion, Assessment and certificate.
