SUBJECT: GRANT OF PERMISSION TO START A VALUE-ADDED CERTIFICATE COURSE IN "CERTIFIED PROGRAM FOR HOSPITAL INFECTION CONTROL" IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY, SANTOSH MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, GHAZIABAD, NCR DELHI.

With reference to her letter dated on 08.06.2020 on the subject cited above, Professor of Microbiology is informed that the request of Department of Microbiology to start a Value-Added Certificate Course in "**Certified Program for Hospital Infection Control**" in the **Department of Microbiology** has been considered and **approved** by the Board of Studies, Academic Council and the Board of the Management in its meeting held on 23.06.2020, 25.06.2020 and 27.06.2020 respectively and is granted permission to start the above certificate course on the following terms and conditions:-

1. Name of the Course

"Certified Program for Hospital Infection Control"

2. Duration of the Course

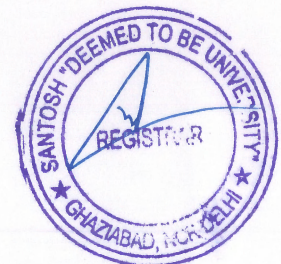
The course will be conducted with 8 hours Session for 3 days and there shall be 2 batches per year containing 50 candidates per batch. [After the scheduled curriculum]

3. Eligibility Criteria

The following are eligible to apply for the said programme:-

- MBBS & PG students
- Infection Control Team members

4. Course Fee: INR 2500/- per student



5. Course Director: Dr. Dakshina Bisht, Professor of Microbiology


6. Course Aim & Objectives, Methodology & Syllabus

- **Aim:** The aim of the course is to train the healthcare workers so as to provide a well supervised expertise in the field of hospital infection control.
- **Objectives:** This program is an endeavor to prepare healthcare professionals for implementation of hospital infection control activities in their day to day practices to prevent hospital acquired infections.
- **Course Syllabus:** Includes Prevention of HAIs, CSSD Infection Control Policy, HAI Surveillance and Prevention of HAIs, HAI surveillance data analysis, spillage management, Antimicrobial Stewardship, Environmental and Staff Surveillance, Disinfection Policy and Infection Control at laundry and kitchen, BMW, Needle stick injury and Hepatitis B Vaccination.
- The participants who fail to take up entire contact classes and evaluation process will not be certified.
- Certification details - "Certified Program for Hospital Infection Control"
- The candidates are required to bring along with them a prepared poster on any HIC related topic. Poster size should be 18" *24"/46 *61 cm.
- Publicizing mechanisms – pamphlets, Email, WhatsApp.
