Venue: Department of Psychiatry

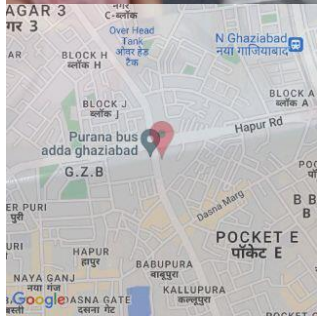

Non-teaching staff members: All nursing Staff posted on duty in Casualty

The Department of psychiatry organized the Non-Teaching development program in the casualty of Santosh Hospital on 01.07.2022. The staff members were educated and demonstrated to learn about the safe technique to deal with violent patient behavior in the casualty setup. They are made aware of the human rights of the psychiatric patient and value them even during the acute psychotic episode. Patient behavior such as aggression and violence need to be controlled adequately which requires 4-5 people to hold all four limbs and a fifth person to hold the hand below the jaw from behind the patient. This physical restraint is important to prevent the risk of harm to self or others in the hospital. This chemical restraints with injectable antipsychotic followed once the patient is stabilized. Then the patient is allowed to remain free for the next half hour till the injectable antipsychotic takes the effect. Sometimes physical restraint continued as 2 points or 3 points for a 20 to 30 minutes period under the direct supervision of hospital staff. Then the patient was evaluated for vitals 1 -2 hourly with needful lab-test samples taken as required.

The staff responded with surprise and confidence after having knowledge of the above technique demonstration and following the steps of code white.



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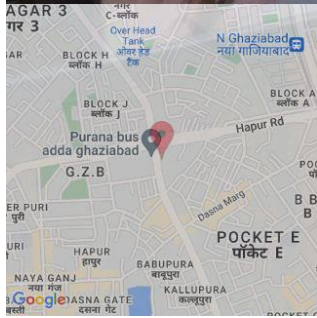

## Segregation of Hospital Bio-Medical Waste

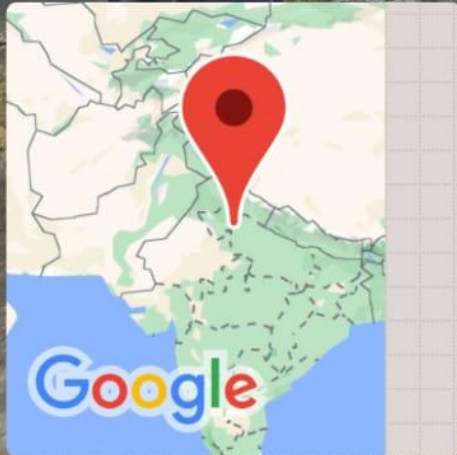

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## **REPORT**

### **HOSPITAL CLINICAL LABORATORY VISIT [COMPETENCY BI 2.5]:**

The department of Biochemistry organized hospital visit for 1st year MBBS students, batch 2021-22 to the Biochemistry laboratory on 2.06.2022 under the guidance of Dr. Juhi Aggarwal, Prof & Head, Department of Biochemistry, Santosh Medical College & Hospital. The session was divided into the groups of about 50 students each who received an introductory session and tour of the biochemistry clinical laboratory. During the introduction, a wide variety of topics were covered, such as the different pre-analytical considerations prior to testing, the field of Biochemistry as a career, and the different roles of the technical staff required to run laboratory testing for a large multi-site healthcare system. Following this introductory meeting, the students were taught a range of concepts bench-side, including how the automated analyzers work, the tests offered in each section of the lab, and clinical application and interpretation of the tests. Not only did students review the individual functions of the tests in each bench area, but they also learned important considerations within the lab, including the software and informatics behind the automation and result reporting, regulatory and inspection requirements, and the importance of critical values. The two-hour experience exposed the students to the significant role of the lab, and its staff plays in generating results that are essential for the diagnosis and management of patients.

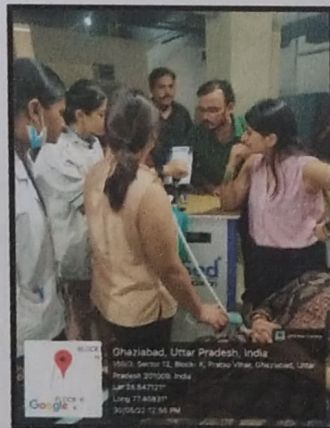
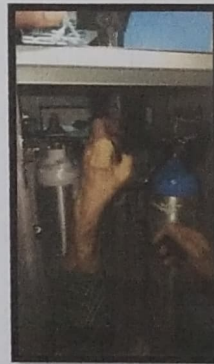
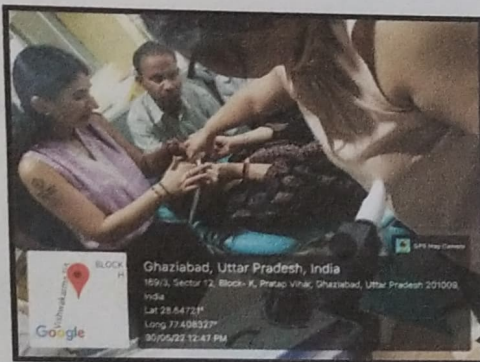
- The event was organized under Dr. Nidhi Gupta , Prof and HOD , Department of Pediatric and Preventive dentistry in collaboration with CONSED.

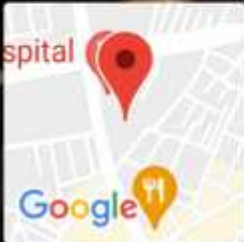

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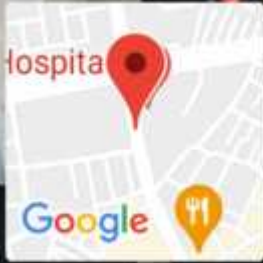

The department of Biochemistry, SDTU organized a 2 day Faculty & non teaching staff development program at the Central lab biochemistry, Santosh Hospital, Ghaziabad on 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> July 2022 from 9-4pm. The participants were given the introduction to the concept and hands on training on ROCHE cobas e-411 which is based on principal of chemiluminescence immunoassay. The cobas e411 analyser is an automated, random access multichannel analyzer for immunological analysis. Immunoassays have become increasingly popular tools for measuring biologic analytes, because they offer sensitive, specific results and are relatively easy to use. Following processes were learned by the staff:

1. System hardware components.
2. Sample processing overview.
3. Assay technology and process overview.

We as clinicians of today should promptly manage GERD and be aware of the scope of medicine in the management of refractory GERD and this CME has propelled us forward in doing so.





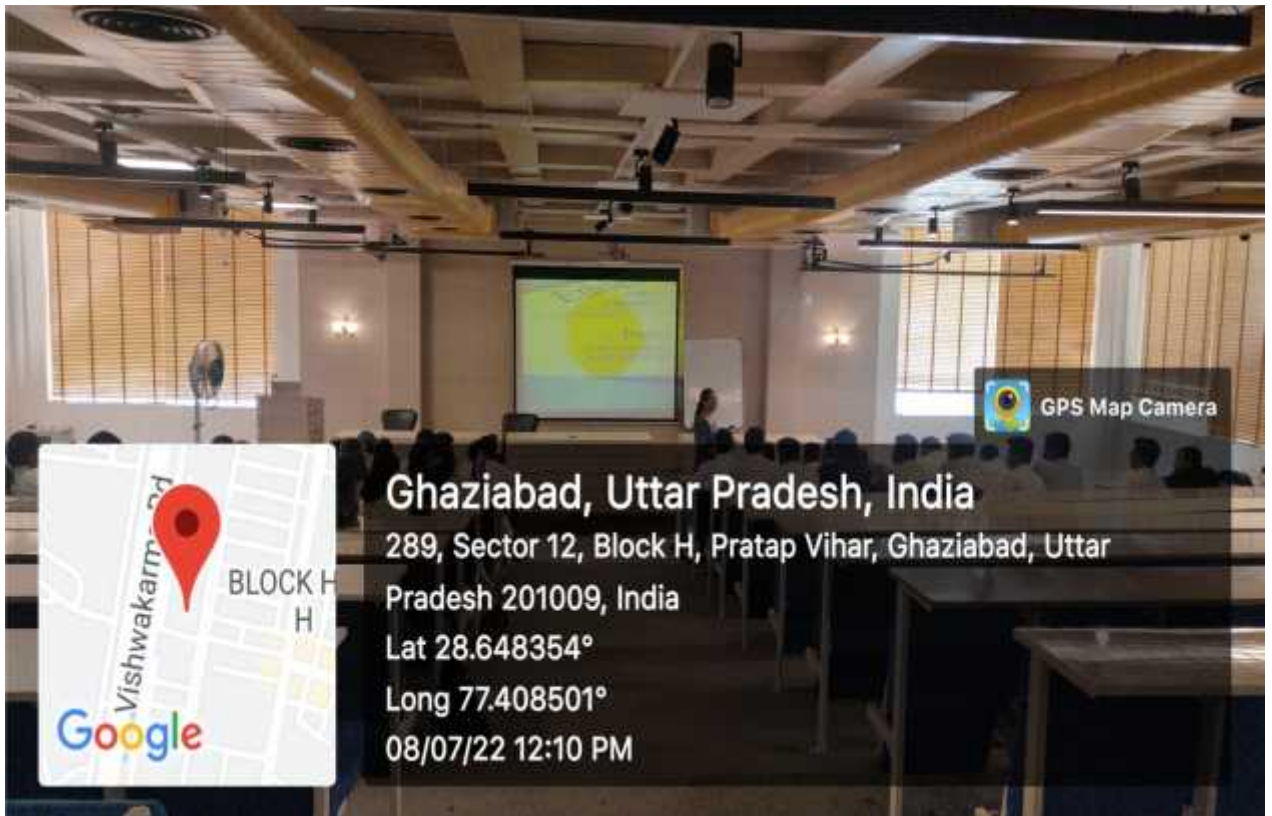




## **Department Of Biochemistry, Santosh Medical College & Hospital, Ghaziabad**

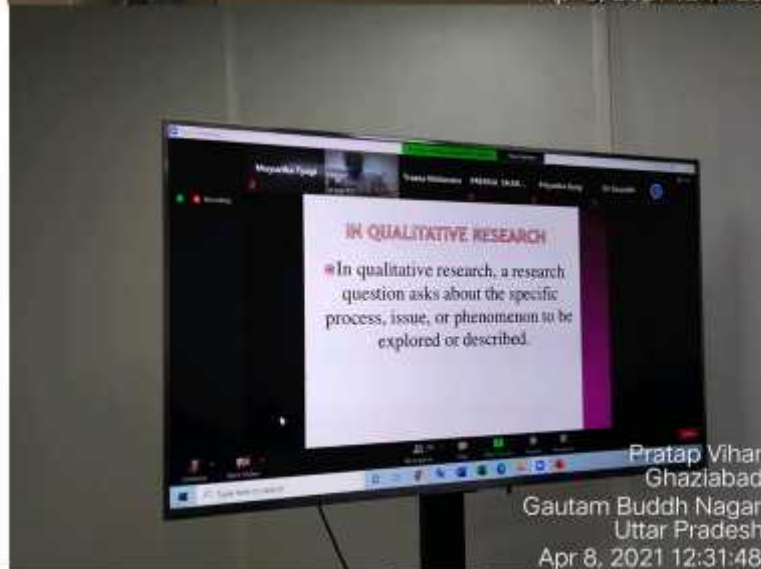
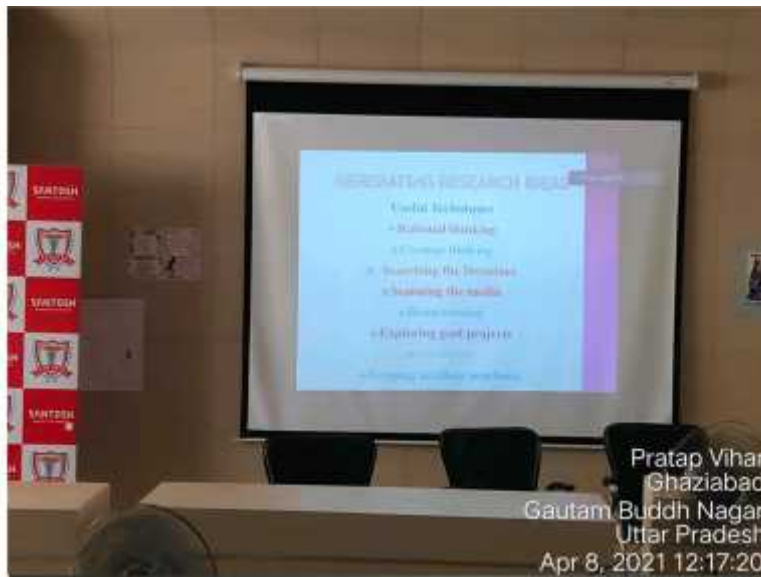

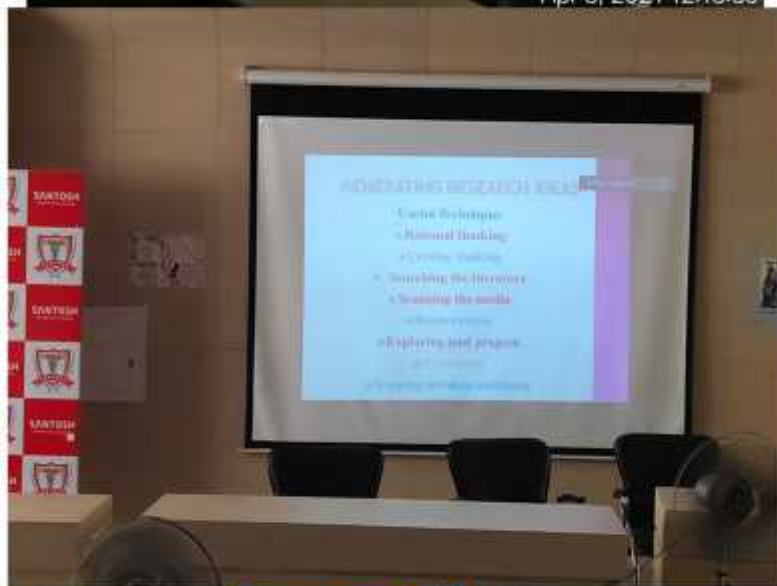

## Sub: Medicine department Blog on "Value Added Certificate Course on "ECG PERFORMING SKILLS AND INTERPRETATION"

On 9th JANUARY 2021 Department of Medicine, Santosh Medical College started a 4 weeks value added course on "**ECG PERFORMING SKILLS AND INTERPRETATION**". The programme was Inaugurated by Dr. Alpana Aggarwal, Medical superintendent in the presence of Dr. Ashok Kumar , HOD , Professor , Medicine Department , Dr. Shivani Bansal, Professor, Medicine and Dr. Manish goyal , Assistant Professor , Medicine. The performing of ECG taking is bit easy task requires the basic technical knowledge of computer and placements of ECG leads but the interpretation of ECG requires intellect, commitment, effort and perhaps most importantly — an organized approach.

Dr. Alpana Aggarwal gave the opening remarks regarding the importance of ECG and an ECG is one of the most important diagnostic tests and is currently used as a gold standard for the diagnosis of a number of cardiac diseases. As it can be a challenging concept to learn, often bringing frustration to the trainees in ECG interpretation but is an important skill to learn as it can save many lives by learning the right approach. Dr. Ashok Kumar, HOD Medicine shared his knowledge and raised the awareness about the basics of ECG, its technique and performing skills . Dr. Ashok kumar suggested a novel approach with the dual benefit of aiding teaching and improving learning and confidence when interpreting an ECG. The session was informative and interesting with practical demonstrations of performing an ECG with the right technique.

The electrocardiogram (ECG) is the primary tool in the diagnosis of acute myocardial infarction. The correct interpretation of ECG may lead to a correct diagnosis, saving the patients from unnecessary tests and potentially harmful therapeutic procedures.

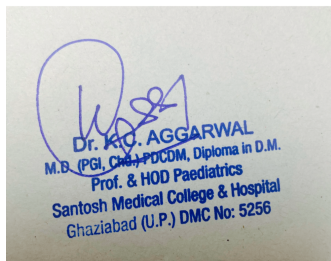

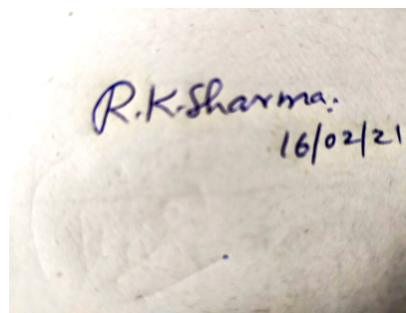

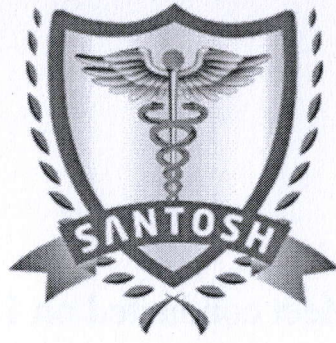

#### CASE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION:

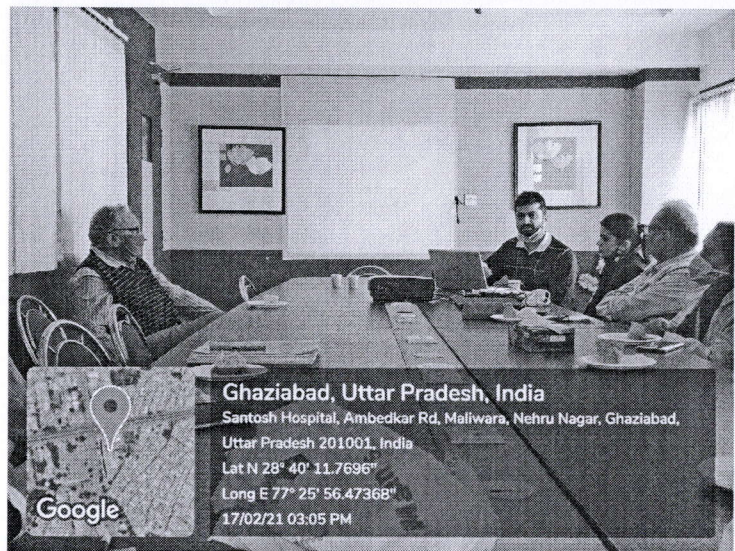
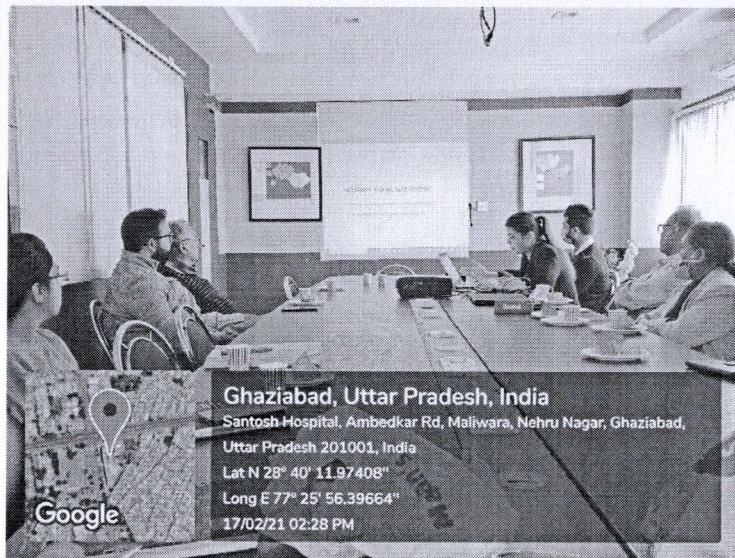
There was a clinical case presentation of a case that had presented to the emergency namely Master Deepanshu, 14 year old, male at Santosh Hospital with unusual presentation of history of fever and severe headache since more than a week along with altered behaviour and irrelevant talking since one day which was admitted to the department of Paediatrics with provisional diagnosis of ?Herpes Encephalitis kept and appropriate investigations were called for ,that all came negative but the complaints persisted hence patient was referred to Department of Psychiatry for reference and after careful evaluation preliminary diagnosis of ? Dissociative Disorder / ? Post- Traumatic Stress Disorder. More careful and detailed clinical psychological evaluation revealed details of traumatic events in the past 2 months along with evidence of forceful alcohol ingestion and signs of physical/sexual abuse were noted.

After meticulous discussion regrading the case all the three departments came to the final conclusive diagnosis of Acute Stress Disorder.

All components and course of the illness in the patient were discussed in great detail and probable differentials.

The case was presented by Dr Anushree Dixit, PG-2, Department of Paediatrics and Dr Jeeten Solanki, PG-2, Department of Psychiatry followed by discussion regarding the case and various aspects of diagnosis and management.





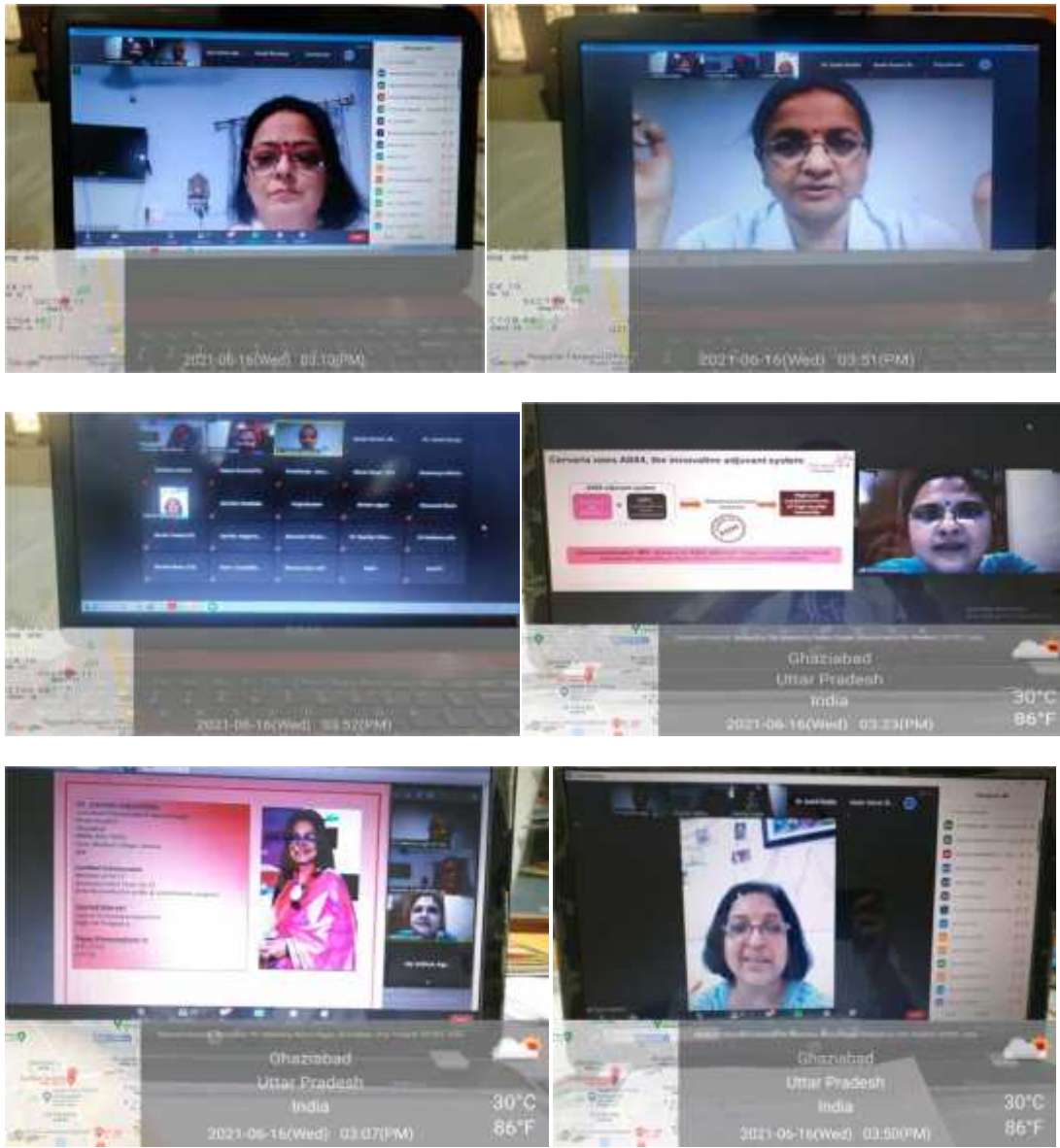


**DAY 2: 16.6.2021**

The session was attended by more than 115 participants and was highly interactive, leaving no doubts about the topic among the audience.

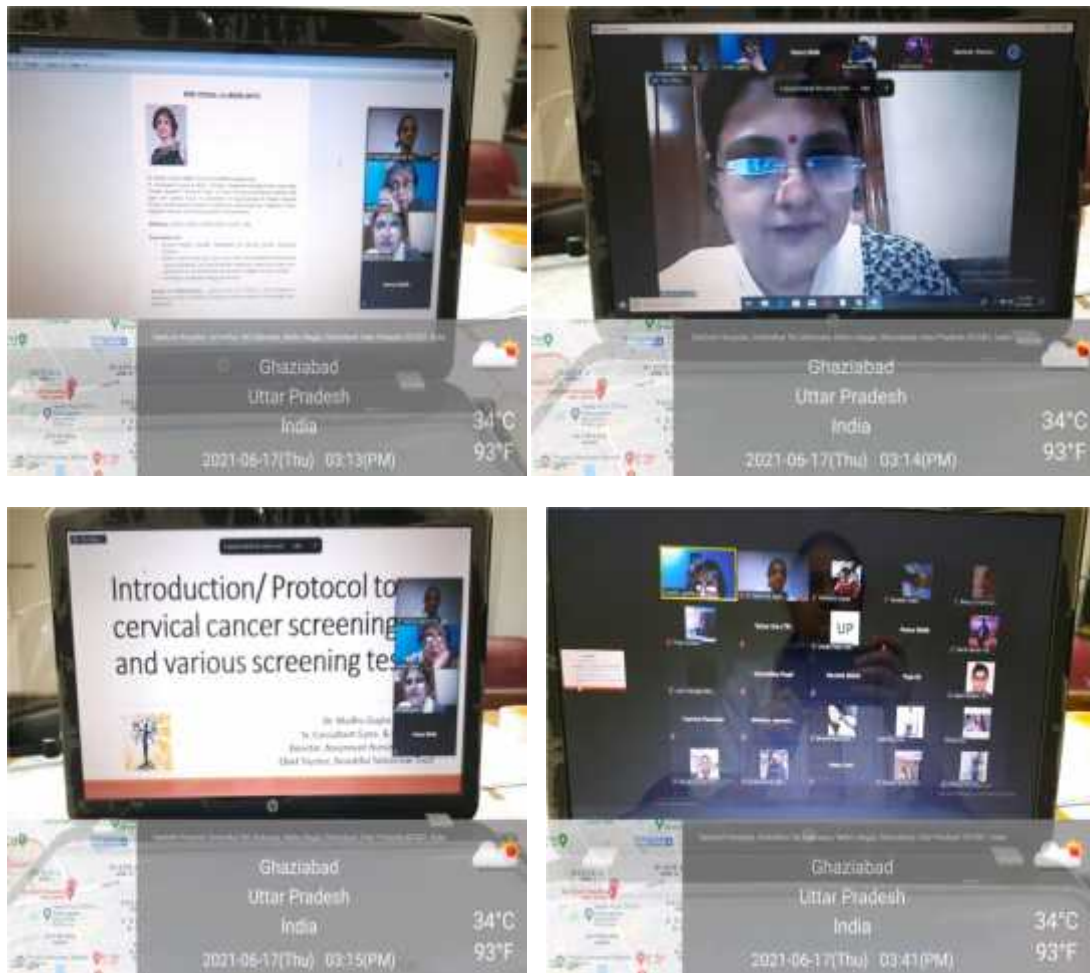


**DAY 3: 17.6.2021**

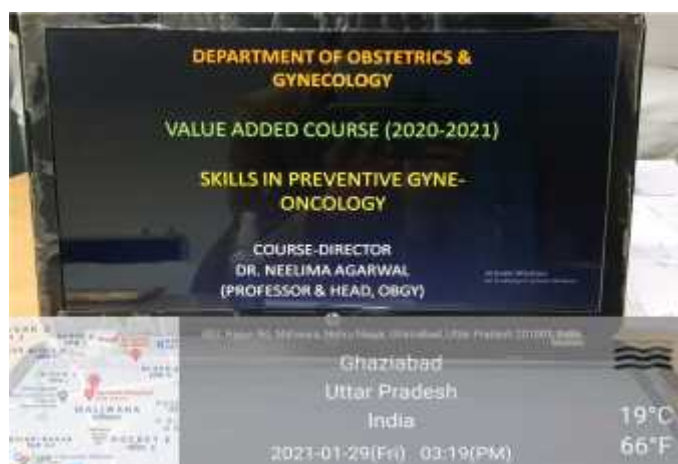

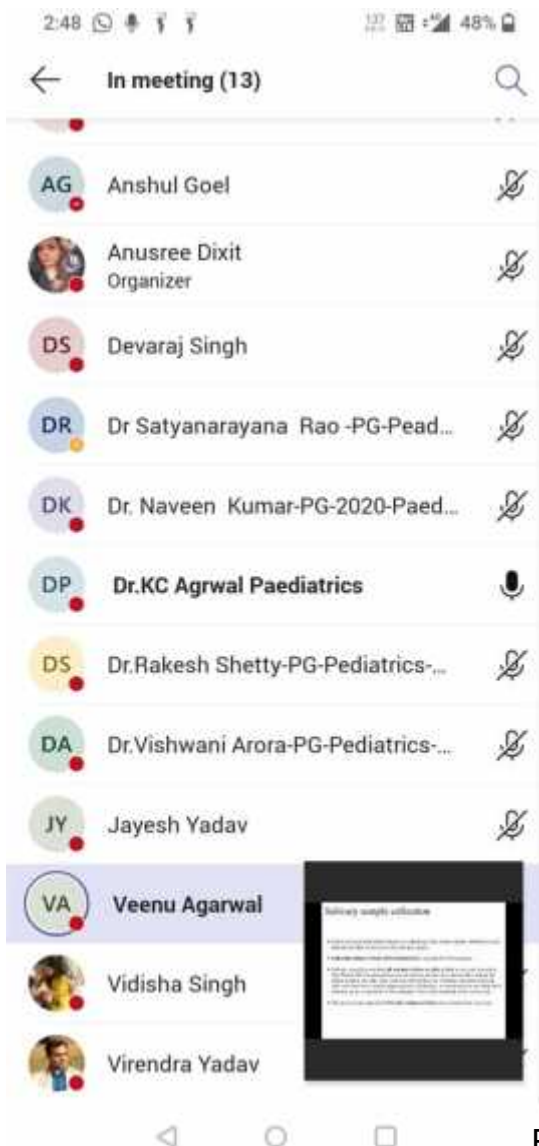
## EVENT DETAILS

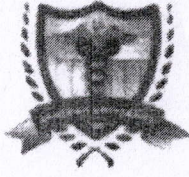
